THE OLDHAM (ROYTON AREA CONSOLIDATION ORDER) PROHIBITION OF WAITING AMENDMENT NO 5 ORDER 2004

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 27th of and may be cited as the Oldham (Royton Area Consolidation Order) Prohibition of Waiting Amendment No. 5 Order 2004
- The Oldham (which Order is hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order" shall have effect as though the weight restrictions detailed in the Schedule hereto are included at Part 1 Schedule 1 to the Principal Order
- 3. This Order shall be construed as one with the Principal Order.

PROHIBITION OF WAITING AMENDMENT ORDER 2004

The Oldham Borough Council have today made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to amend the Oldham - Royton Area Consolidation Order 2003 by introducing 'At any time' waiting restrictions on Church Street, Royton, (North West Side) extending from a point 24 metres north east of its junction with Chapel Croft for a distance of 48 metres in northerly and easterly direction and on Church Street, Royton (East Side at cul-de-sac end) extending from a point 35 metres north east of its junction with Chapel Croft for a distance of 13 metres in a northerly direction

The Order will come into operation on 27bn October 2004

A copy of the Order and a map showing the lengths of road referred to and a copy of the Council's statement of reasons may be examined at my office between the hours of 8.40am and 5.00pm Mondays to Fridays (Room 222, Civic Centre, West Street, Oldham, Telephone 0161 911 4836 Ref: LJM/TO16/04).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date hereof apply to the High Court for the purpose.
