ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE OLDHAM (LEES AREA CONSOLIDATION ORDER) PERMITTED PARKING AMENDMENT NO. 1 ORDER 2004

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 6th December 2004 and may be cited as the Oldham (Lees Area Consolidation Order) Permitted Parking Amendment No.1 Order 2004.
2. The Oldham Lees Area Consolidation Order 2003 (which Order is hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order" shall have effect as though the Permitted Parking Amendment detailed in the Schedule below were included at Part 1 Schedule 2
3. This Order shall be construed as one with the Principal Order.

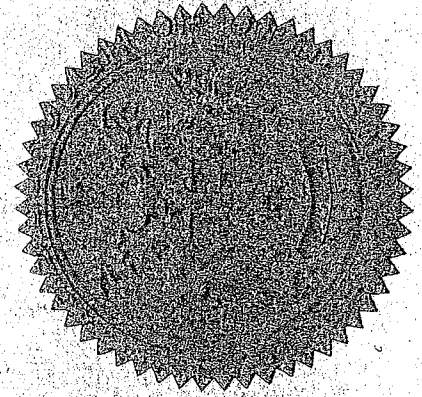
