THE OLDHAM (OLDHAM AREA CONSOLIDATION ORDER) HACKNEY CARRIAGE STANDS PROHIBITION OF STOPPING EXPERIMENTAL AMENDMENT ORDER 2004

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 30th April 2004 for 18 months until 23rd October 2005 and may be cited as the Oldham (Oldham Area Consolidation Order) Prohibition of Stopping Experimental Amendment Order 2004.
- 2. The Oldham (Oldham Area) Consolidation Order 2003 (which Order is hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order" shall have effect as though the prohibition of stopping restrictions on the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto were included at Part 1 Schedule 1 of the Principal Order.
- 3. This Order shall be construed as one with the Principal Order.
