ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE OLDHAM - RETLEY PASSAGE (OLDHAM)
PROHIBITION OF WAITING ORDER 2000

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 30th November 2000 and may be cited as the Oldham - Retley Passage (Oldham) Prohibition of Waiting Order 2000.

2. (1) In this Order:-

"disabled person's badge" in respect of a badge issued by a local authority before 2nd March 1992 has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982.

"disabled person's badge" in respect of a badge issued by a local authority after 2nd March 1992 has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982, as amended by The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 1991.

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986;

"parking disc" in respect of a disc issued by a local authority before 2nd March 1992 means a disc, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No.4631:1970) but coloured orange and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

"parking disc" in respect of a disc issued by a local authority after 2nd March 1992 means a disc being 125mm square coloured orange and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-

(i) a disabled person's badge issued before 2nd March 1992 in the relevant position if -

(a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen and with its front facing forward so as to be legible from outside the vehicle; or

(b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.

(ii) a disabled persons badge issued on or after 2nd March 1992 in the relevant position if -

The Oldham Borough Council, have today made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which is to prohibit waiting in any of the sides of length of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

This Order will come into operation on 30th November 2000.

Appropriate exemptions are included in the Order.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the length of road referred to and a copy of the Council's statement of reasons may be examined at my office between the hours of 8.40am and 5.00pm Mondays to Fridays, (Room 222, Civic Centre, West Street, Oldham, Telephone 0161 911 4842 Ref: JFH/TO31/00).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from 9th November 2000 apply to the High Court for the purpose.
