THE OLDHAM - FREDERICK STREET (OLDHAM)
PROHIBITION OF WAITING ORDER 1998

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 29 March 2000 and may be cited as the Oldham - Frederick Street (Oldham) Prohibition of Waiting Order 1998

2. (1) In this Order:-

"disabled person's badge" in respect of a badge issued by a local authority before 2nd March 1992 has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982.

"disabled person's badge" in respect of a badge issued by a local authority after 2nd March 1992 has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982, as amended by The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 1991.

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986;

"parking disc" in respect of a disc issued by a local authority before 2nd March 1992 means a disc, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS No.4631:1970) but coloured orange and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

"parking disc" in respect of a disc issued by a local authority after 2nd March 1992 means a disc being 125mm square coloured orange and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-

(i) a disabled person's badge issued before 2nd March 1992 in the relevant position if -

(a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen and with its front facing forward so as to be legible from outside the vehicle; or

(b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.

(ii) a disabled persons badge issued on or after 2nd March 1992 in the relevant position if -

electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (e) the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the lengths of roads for so long as is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral; or
 - (f) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Article 3 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the lengths of roads referred to in that Article for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road on the same day).
5. The prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

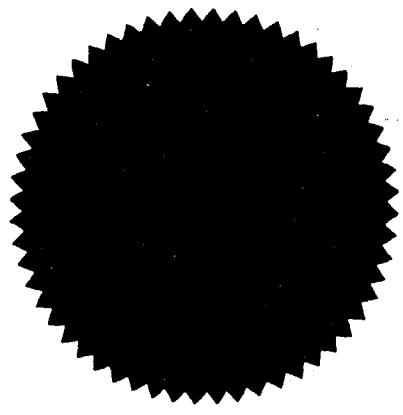
SCHEDULE

Lengths of road at Frederick Street
in the Borough of Oldham

No Waiting at Any Time

<u>Road</u>	<u>Length</u>	<u>Side(s)</u>
Frederick Street ✓	From a point 60 metres north west of its junction with Regency Close to a point 25 metres south east of its junction with Regency Close.	North east
Frederick Street ✓	From a point 15 metres north west of its junction with Selkirk Avenue for a distance of 10 metres in a north westerly direction.	South west
Frederick Street ✓	From a point 15 metres south east of its junction with Selkirk Avenue for a distance of 10 metres in a south easterly direction.	South west
