THE OLDHAM (OLDHAM AREA CONSOLIDATION ORDER)
PROHIBITION OF WAITING AMENDMENT NO 9 ORDER 2004

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 26th April 2004 and may be cited as the Oldham - The Oldham - Oldham Area Consolidation Order Prohibition of Waiting Amendment No 9 Order 2004.
2. The Oldham Area Consolidation Order 2003 (which Order is hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order") shall have effect as though the Prohibitions of Waiting restrictions detailed in the Schedule hereto were included in the Principal Order at Part 1 Schedule 2.
3. This Order shall be construed as one with the Principal Order.
