

OLDHAM BOROUGH COUNCILROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984THE OLDHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL – NEWTOWN STREET, SHAW  
EXPERIMENTAL PROHIBITION OF DRIVING ORDER 2008

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 20<sup>th</sup> October 2008 and may be cited as the Oldham – Newtown Street, Shaw Experimental Prohibition of Driving Order 2008 and will continue in force for 18 months until 20<sup>th</sup> April 2010.
2. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
4. Save as provided in Article 6, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter, wait or proceed in the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order at any time on any day except:-
  - (i) upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer.
  - (ii) for the purpose of access to premises situated on or adjacent to those highways or accessible only from those highways.
5. Save as provided in Article 6, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
6. Nothing in Articles 4 and 5 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road referred to therein where that vehicle is being used:
  - (a) for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) for the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road or any other adjacent length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (c) if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

6. The Executive Director, Environment and Transportation for Oldham Borough Council or a person authorised by him, if it appears to him or that person to be essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, and after:-

- (i) consulting the Chief Constable of Greater Manchester Police, and
- (ii) giving such public notice as the Secretary of State may direct,

may make modifications of any description to this Order (other than additions) or suspend it.

SCHEDULE 1

No vehicle to enter, wait or proceed except for the purpose of access to premises

Newtown Street, Shaw

From its junction with Market Street to its junction with Eastway, but excluding the access to the British Legion Club and 4-8 Eastway.

SCHEDULE 2

Prohibition of Driving

Length

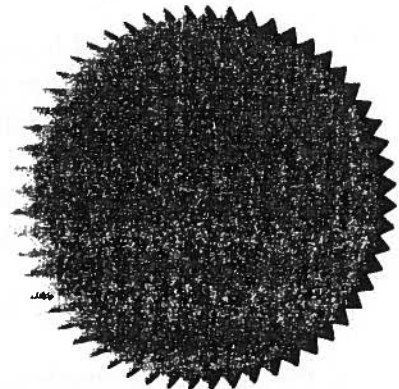
Newtown Street, Shaw
