ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE OLDHAM (ROYTON AREA CONSOLIDATION ORDER)
LOADING AND UNLOADING AMENDMENT NO.8 ORDER 2005

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 31st October 2005 and may be cited as the Oldham - (Royton Area Consolidation Order) Loading and Unloading Amendment No. 8 Order 2005.
2. The Oldham Royton Area Consolidation Order 2003 (which Order is hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order") shall have effect as though the loading restrictions set out in Schedule 1 hereto are deleted from the Principal Order Part 2 Schedule iv and replaced by the loading restriction detailed in Schedule hereto.
