**THE OLDHAM – ROCHDALE ROAD HIGH CROMPTON
PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ORDER 2010**

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 28th July 2010 and may be cited as the Oldham – Rochdale Road High Crompton Prohibition of Stopping Order 2010.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to stop during the times specified in the Schedule below in any of the sides or lengths of roads specified in the said Schedule to this Order.
3. (1) Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to stop in any of the sides or lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) building or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the lengths of roads or any other adjacent length of road;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties ;or
 - (c) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
4. The prohibition and restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

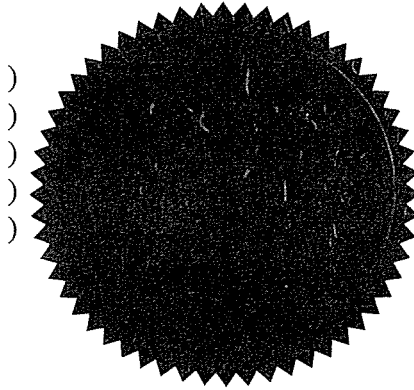

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**THE OLDHAM – ROCHDALE ROAD HIGH CROMPTON
PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ORDER 2010**

The Oldham Borough Council have today made any Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which is to Prohibit Stopping between the hours 8am to 5pm Monday to Friday on the east side of Rochdale Road at the entrance to Crompton House School on the school entrance markings.

The Order will come into operation on 28th July 2010.

Approximate exemptions will be included in the Order.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the lengths of roads referred to and a copy of the Council's statement of reasons may be examined at my office between the hours of 8.40am and 6.00pm on Mondays to Fridays (Civic Entrance, Civic Centre, West Street, Oldham, Telephone 0161 770 4836 Ref: LJM/TO48/08).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date hereof apply to the High Court for the purpose.
