# **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

### THE OLDHAM – ROYTON AREA CONSOLIDATION ORDER (DISABLED BAYS) <u>AMENDMENT NO 20 ORDER 2011</u>

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following order: -

- This Order shall come into operation on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2011 and may be cited as the Oldham – Royton Area Consolidation Order (Disabled Bays) Amendment No 20 Order 2011.
- 2. The Oldham Royton Area Consolidation Order 2003 (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order") shall have effect as though the disabled persons parking places detailed in the Schedule hereto are included in the Principal Order at Part 11 Schedule 4 from the date hereof
- 3. This Order shall be construed as one with the Principal Order.
