# THE OLDHAM – BRIERLEY AVENUE, FAILSWORTH PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ORDER 2011

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2011 and may be cited as the Oldham Brierley Avenue, Failsworth Prohibition of Stopping Order 2011.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to stop during the times specified in the Schedule below in any of the sides of lengths of roads specified in the said Schedule to this Order.
- 3. (1) Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to stop in any of the sides of lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
  - (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
    - (i) building or demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the lengths of roads or any other adjacent length of road;
    - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (c) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- 4. The prohibition and restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

## Mandatory School Keep Clear Markings Monday to Friday 8am to 5pm

### Length of Road

#### **Exemptions**

Brierley Avenue (both sides) from a point 68 metres from its junction B1,B3,B4,C,E,J with Ashton Road East for a distance of 27 metres in a south westerly direction.

Brierley Avenue (north side) from a point 147 metres from its junction B1,B3,B4,C,E,J with Ashton Road East for a distance of 24.6 metres in a south westerly direction.

Brierley Avenue (south side) from a point 147 metres from its junction B1,B3,B4,C,E,J with Ashton Road East for a distance of 43.6 metres in a south westerly direction.

Brierley Avenue (both sides) from a point 206 metres from its junction B1,B3,B4,C,E,J with Ashton Road East for a distance of 21 metres in a south westerly direction.

Brierley Avenue (both sides) from a point 253 metres from its junction B1,B3,B4,C,E,J with Ashton Road East for a distance of 26 metres in a south westerly direction.
