<u>THE OLDHAM – OLDHAM TOWN CENTRE</u> <u>CAR PARKING ORDER 2013</u>

The Oldham Borough Council on 4th January 2013 made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which is to:-

increase the period of 'no return within' on all Oldham Town Centre Car Parks to 3 hours for the period 6th January 2013 to 5th April 2013 with the effect that after the first ticket displayed has expired 3 hours must elapse before the vehicle can return to that car park and

amend the maximum period of waiting on Tommyfield Car Park and Clegg Street Bus Station Car Park to 4 hours to give effect to 2 hours free parking 7 days a week and then introduce charges for the 2 hours following. There is no provision for parking in excess of 4 hours and fixed penalty notices will be issued for the overstay.

The Order will come into operation on 5th January 2013 and will continue in force until 5th April 2013.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the lengths of roads referred to and a copy of the Council's statement of reasons may be examined at my office between the hours of 8.40am and 5.00pm on Mondays to Fridays (Civic Reception, Civic Centre, West Street, Oldham, Telephone 0161 770 4836 Ref: LJM/TO).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date hereof apply to the High Court for the purpose.
