THE OLDHAM FAILSWORTH AREA CONSOLIDATION ORDER PROHIBITION OF WAITING AMENDMENT ORDER 2014

PADDOCK LANE AREA FAILSWORTH

The Oldham Borough Council, have today made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which is to introduce waiting restrictions on Monday to Friday 8am to 5pm on the north side of Paddock Lane from its junction with Somerset Road for a distance of 32 metres in a north easterly direction and on the south and east side of Paddock Lane from its junction with Prospect Drive for a distance of 70 metres in a south westerly and then southerly direction and on the west side of Prospect Drive from its junction with Paddock Lane for a distance of 25 metres in a southerly direction and on the east side of Prospect Drive from its junction with Paddock Lane for a distance of 22 metres in a southerly direction and on the east side of Somerset Road from its junction with Paddock Lane for a distance of 20 metres in a northerly direction.

The Order will come into operation on 10th January 2014

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date hereof apply to the High Court for the purpose.

THE OLDHAM - FAILSWORTH AREA CONSOLIDATION ORDER PROHIBITION OF WAITING AMENDMENT NO 24 ORDER 2014

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- The Oldham Failsworth Area Consolidation Order 2003 (which Order is hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order") shall have effect as though the waiting restrictions detailed in the Schedule below are included in the Principal Order at Part 1 Schedule 1 from the date hereof.
- 3. This Order shall be construed as one with the Principal Order.
