## THE OLDHAM AREA CONSOLIDATION ORDER PROHIBITION OF STOPPING WAITING & LOADING AMENDMENT ORDER 2014

#### **NEW RADCLIFFE STREET**

The Oldham Borough Council, have today made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which is to reinstate no waiting at any time on the south side of New Radcliffe Street from its junction with Henshaw Street to its junction with Fountain Street and no loading at any time on the north side of New Radcliffe Street from its junction with Fountain Street to its junction with Henshaw Street and on the south side of New Radcliffe Street from its junction with Henshaw Street for a distance of 14 metres in a westerly direction and no stopping/loading or waiting at any time with the exception of Hackney Carriages on the north side of New Radcliffe Street from its junction with Fountain Street to its junction with Henshaw Street

The Order will come into operation on 10<sup>TH</sup> January 2014

A copy of the Order and a map showing the lengths of road referred to and a copy of the Council's statement of reasons may be examined at my office between the hours of 8.40am and 5.00pm Mondays to Fridays (Civic Entrance), Civic Centre, West Street, Oldham, Telephone 0161 770 4836 Ref: LJM/TO13/25).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within 6 weeks from the date hereof apply to the High Court for the purpose.

# THE OLDHAM – NEW RADCLIFFE STREET HACKNEY CARRIAGE STAND PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ORDER 2014

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(1) and 4(2) the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on 10<sup>th</sup> January 2014 and may be cited as the Oldham New Radcliffe Street Hackney Carriage Stand Prohibition of Stopping Order 2014
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to stop during the times specified in the Schedule below in any of the sides of lengths of roads specified in the said Schedule to this Order unless those vehicles are Hackney Carriages the proprietors of which hold a valid licence granted under Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847
- 3. (1) Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to stop in any of the sides of lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
  - (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:
    - building or demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the lengths of roads or any other adjacent length of road;
    - the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
  - (c) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

4. The prohibition and restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
