COMMENCING FRIDAY, 13 JUNE 2014

Restrictions to apply on Friday, 13 JUNE 2014 from 0800hrs to midnight

AFFECTED ROADS Description of length of road and affected side(s):

- (a) ✓ **Stockport Road, Lydgate - Both sides**
From its junction with Oldham Road for a distance of 180 metres in a southerly direction
- (b) ✓ **Burnedge Lane, Lydgate - Both sides**
From its junction with Platting Road for a distance of 20 metres in a north-easterly direction
- (c) ✓ **Platting Road, Lydgate - East side**
From its junction with Oldham Road to its junction with Burnedge Lane
- (d) ✓ **Oldham Road, Lydgate and Grasscroft** ✓
Both sides – From a point 40 metres northwest of its junction with Platting Road for a distance of 160 metres in a generally northwesterly direction (ending at street lamp no 49)
South side – From a point 70 metres east of its junction with North View Close to a point 45 metres west of its junction with Beechfield
- (e) ✓ **Platting Road, Lydgate - West side**
From its junction with Oldham Road to a point 35 metres north of its junction with Carr Lea
