THE OLDHAM - WELLINGTON STREET PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN ORDER 2021

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections Section 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2), & 9 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following order: -

- This Order made on 18th October 2021 shall come into operation on 25th October 2021 and may be cited as the Oldham – Wellington Street Prohibition of Right Turn Order 2021
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding along Wellington Street to turn right into Rhodes Bank. Every person causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed along Wellington Street shall on reaching the junction of Rhodes Bank and Union Street shall cause that vehicle to turn left onto Rhodes Bank
- 3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
