

## OLDHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

### THE OLDHAM – ROCHDALE ROAD HIGH CROMPTON SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ORDER 2021

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order made on 19<sup>th</sup> February 2021 shall come into operation on 26<sup>th</sup> February 2021 and may be cited as the Oldham – Rochdale Road High Crompton School Keep Clear Prohibition of Stopping Order 2021
  2. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to stop from 8am to 10pm on all days on the lengths of roads specified in the Second Schedule below.
  3. (1) Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to stop in any of the sides of lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
    - (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
      - (i) building or demolition operations;
      - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
      - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the lengths of roads or any other adjacent length of road;
      - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
    - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
    - (c) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
  3. (2) Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to stop in any of the sides of lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
    - (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
      - (i) building or demolition operations;
      - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
      - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the lengths of roads or any other adjacent length of road;
      - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
    - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
    - (c) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
4. The prohibition and restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
5. The entries detailed in the First Schedule below shall be deleted from The Oldham – Schools Keep Clear Prohibition of Stopping No 2 Order 2015 from the date of this Order

**Mandatory School Keep Clear Markings on all days 8am to 10pm**

From a point 38.2 metres south east of its junction with Moorfield Hamlet for a distance of 25.56 metres in a south easterly direction

**Rochdale Road**

(north east side)

From a point 112.1 metres south east of its junction with Moorfield Hamlet for a distance of 25.56 metres in a south easterly direction

**Mandatory School Keep Clear Markings on all days 8am to 10pm**

(north east side)

From a point 11.3 metres south east of its junction with Moorfield Hamlet for a distance of 43.56 metres in a south easterly direction

From a point 112.1 metres south east of its junction with Moorfield Hamlet for a distance of 25.56 metres in a south easterly direction
