# THE OLDHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (OLDHAM AREA/CHADDERTON AREA/CROMPTON AREA/FAILSWORTH AREA/LEES AREA/ROYTON AREA AND SADDLEWORTH AREA) CONSOLIDATION ORDERS 2003 AMENDMENT NUMBER 156 ORDER 2017

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 24 April 2017 and may be cited as the Oldham Borough Council (Oldham Area/Chadderton Area/Crompton Area/Failsworth Area/Lees Area/Royton Area and Saddleworth Area) Consolidation Orders 2003 Amendment Number 156 Order 2017.
- 2. The Oldham Borough Council (Chadderton Area) Consolidation Order 2003, the Oldham Borough Council (Crompton Area) Consolidation Order 2003, the Oldham Borough Council (Failsworth Area) Consolidation Order 2003, the Oldham Borough Council (Lees Area) Consolidation Order 2003, the Oldham Borough Council (Oldham Area) Consolidation Order 2003, the Oldham Borough Council (Royton Area) Consolidation Order 2003 and the Oldham Borough Council (Saddleworth Area) Consolidation Order 2003 ("the Principal Orders") shall be amended by the insertion of the additional definition and Articles as detailed in the Schedule to this Order.
- 4. This Order shall be construed as one with the Principal Orders.

### SCHEDULE

## **AMENDMENTS TO THE PRINCIPAL ORDERS**

Insert the following wording after paragraph 59 of the Definitions section of the Principal Orders:

(59A) "Loading Only Parking Bay" means a parking bay authorised under Article 25 of Part II of this Order marked out by white lines or otherwise including the words "Loading Only" and to be used only for the purposes of loading and unloading.

Insert the following wording after Article 1(6) of the Principal Orders:

(7) Where a Parking Place has been marked out with Parking Bays, no driver of a vehicle shall cause or permit the Vehicle to wait in a position other than in a marked Parking Bay and every Vehicle left in a marked Parking Bay or Parking Place shall so stand that every part of the Vehicle is wholly within the limits of the marked Parking Bay or Parking Place Amend the first part of the first sentence of Article 9 of the Principal Orders to read as follows:

9. Every vehicle left in a Parking Place in accordance with Articles 4, 6, 8 or 16 of Part II of this Order shall not stand other than so:-

Amend Article 30 of the Principal Orders to read as follows:

30. No driver of a Vehicle shall cause or permit the Vehicle to wait in a position of the than in a marked Parking Bay or specified position in the Parking Place and every Vehicle left in a marked Parking Bay or Parking Place shall so stand that every part of the Vehicle is wholly within the limits of the marked Parking Bay or Parking Place

Insert the following wording at Article 32 of the Principal Orders:

- 32. No person shall except with the permission of any person duly authorised by the Council in that behalf, cause or permit any vehicle to wait within a Loading Only Parking Bay except for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle, nor cause nor permit the loading or unloading of goods from the vehicle for a longer period than 30 minutes in relation to a Loading Only Parking Bay, nor cause nor permit a vehicle to return to a Loading Only Parking Bay if a period of less than 1 hour has elapsed since the termination of the last period of loading or unloading by that vehicle in the same Loading Only Parking Bay.
- 32A. The driver of any vehicle waiting within a Loading Only Parking Bay shall position that vehicle such that it is wholly within the limits of the said Loading Only Parking Bay.
