PROPOSED BUS STOP CLEARWAYS - QUALITY BUS CORRIDORS, VARIOUS LOCATIONS, OLDHAM

REPORT TO EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES

1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 The purpose of this report is to consider the introduction of Bus Stop Clearways on all bus stops on Quality Bus Corridors (QBC) routes in Oldham.

2.0 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 2.1 The bus stops have been upgraded to improve the environment around bus stops along Quality Bus Corridor routes.
- 2.2 As part of the Quality Bus Corridor Programme for the Saddleworth to Manchester (A62) and Rochdale, Oldham, Ashton, Hyde (ROAH) Corridors, it is proposed to introduce Bus Stop Clearway Restrictions at each Bus Stop location to allow unimpeded access to the stop for buses, improve journey times and to allow passengers to board and alight the bus safely.

3.0 RECOMMENDATION

3.1 It is recommended that Bus Stop Clearways at all bus stops be introduced on QBC routes as detailed in the Schedule appended to this report and in accordance with the procedure previously set up to create Bus Stop Clearways. (EDRS Ref No 0409155 refers).

PROPOSED BUS STOP CLEARWAYS - QUALITY BUS CORRIDORS, VARIOUS LOCATIONS, OLDHAM

4.0 INTRODUCTION

4.1 The bus priority measures implemented under Quality Bus Corridor routes have been designed to promote bus travel. This is part of the Countywide programme being implemented throughout the Borough, part of which aims to improve safety and enable near-level access at the bus stops for all members of the community. The introduction of Bus Stop Clearways at these locations will allow easier access to the bus stop for buses and passengers alike.

5.0 BACKGROUND

5.1 A number of bus priority measures have been implemented along two Quality Bus Corridors which are Manchester-Oldham-Saddleworth (A62) and Rochdale-Oldham-Ashton-Hvde (A671/A627). The measures included an upgrading of the existing The aim is to make bus travel easier and more attractive. The upgrade makes it easier for all people to get on and off the bus particularly older people, people with push chairs, wheelchair users and people with visual impairment. It will also maximise benefit from low floor buses, allowing buses to stop next to the kerb, providing almost level access for bus users. above facilities provided at the bus stop must have access at all times for bus passengers. It is therefore essential that the buses have unimpeded access to bus stops at all times. To facilitate this it is proposed to provide bus stop clearways at locations along QBC routes only.

6.0 JUSTIFICATION

6.1 Bus Stop Clearways impose restrictions on parking and stopping of vehicles within the diagram 1025.1 markings at a Bus Stop. Without the restriction indiscriminate parking can occur which can prevent safe and efficient access by buses to the designated stop with its improved arrangements.

7.0 CONSULTATIONS

- 7.1 G.M.P. View The Chief Constable has been consulted and has no objection to this proposal.
- 7.2 G.M.P.T.E. View The Director General has been consulted and supports this proposal but considers that 24 hour operation is necessary as many buses, particularly on QBC routes operate beyond the 7am-7pm period proposed and there are many disabled passengers who use buses and require the facilities that are afforded at modern boarding points outside the proposed period.
- 7.3 G.M. Fire Service View The County Fire Officer has been consulted and has no objection to this proposal.
- 7.4 G.M. Ambulance Service View The County Ambulance Officer has been consulted and has no comment on this proposal.

8.0 COMMENTS OF WARD COUNCILLORS

8.1 The Ward Councillors have been consulted on the proposals and shown the locations of each stop within their Ward. There have been no adverse comments.

9.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

9.1 The estimated cost of implementing the scheme is detailed below:-

9.2 The scheme is part of the QBC integrated transport plan funded by the LTP Top Slice Programme for the financial year 2006/07 under the bus stop upgrade allocations.

10.0 LEGAL SERVICES' COMMENTS

10.1 Since 2002 it has been possible to introduce a bus stop clearway without the need for a Traffic Regulation Order. As mentioned in paragraph 3.1, the Council has introduced an approvals procedure for dealing with bus stop clearways which to a large extent mirrors the procedure to be followed when making Traffic Regulation Orders and it is recommended that the approval procedure be followed. (AE)

11.0 TREASURER'S COMMENTS

11.1 Capital

The implementation costs will be capital expenditure and a charge against the Transport Capital Programme. This will form part of the bigger scheme of Bus Stop Upgrades of which there is a budget of £519k funded by GMPTE top Slice. (KK)

11.2 Revenue

The annual maintenance costs associated with the proposal are £1,000 and will be a charge against the Environmental Services Directorate's Highways Maintenance Budget.

There is no provision within the existing budget.

The additional costs will be taken into account as part of the process of setting the Council's 2008/09 revenue budget (DS).

14.0 ENVIRONMENTAL AND HEALTH AND SAFETY IMPLICATIONS

- 14.1 Energy This proposal should reduce the consumption of energy by encouraging a shift of transport modes from private cars to public transport.
- 14.2 Transport The proposals should improve the quality of public transport and thus encourage its use.
- 14.3 Pollution A reduction in the use of private cars, when achieved, would reduce the level of air pollution and help to promote better health for the public and protect the environment.
- 14.4 Consumption and Use of Resources The proposals should reduce the use of private cars thus reducing the overall consumption and use of resources.
- 14.5 Built Environment The introduction of the bus stop clearways will alter the appearance of the area.
- 14.6 Natural Environment The proposals will not significantly alter the appearance of the area.
- 14.7 Health and Safety The improvement to bus stop environment including clearways would allow safe passenger access to buses.
