## OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WEST OXFORDSHIRE DISTRICT) (DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No.7) ORDER 2013

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers contained in Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35 and 45 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (West Oxfordshire District) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (Amendment No.7) Order 2013 and shall come into operation on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of September 2013.
- (1) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa
  - (2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment
  - (3) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall unless the context otherwise requires be construed as a reference to the numbered Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

The Oxfordshire County Council (West Oxfordshire District) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order 2006, as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (West Oxfordshire District) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 2007, the Oxfordshire County Council (West Oxfordshire District) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (Amendment No.2) Order 2009, the Oxfordshire County Council (West Oxfordshire District) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (Amendment No.3) Order 2011, and the Oxfordshire County Council (West Oxfordshire District) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (Amendment No 4) Order 2012, the Oxfordshire County Council (West Oxfordshire District) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (Amendment No 5) Order 2012, and the Oxfordshire County Council (West Oxfordshire District) (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) (Amendment No 6) 2013 ("the 2006 Order"), is amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.
