

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS - WEST OXFORDSHIRE) (PROHIBITION AND
RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PERMITTED PARKING)
(VARIATION NO.13) ORDER 2019**

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 & 45 and Part IV Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads – West Oxfordshire) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Permitted Parking) (Variation No.13) Order 2018 and shall come into force on the 30th day of November 2018.
2.
 - (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
 - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.
 - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.

ITEM 19 of **Schedule 15** ‘No Waiting at any Time’ is deleted and replaced as follows:

“ITEM 19: CHIPPING NORTON

1. Albion Street:

(a) East side - the whole length.

(b) West side:

(i) from its junction with London Road southwards to a point 40.5 metres north of its junction with Rowell Way;

(ii) from its junction with Burford Road northwards to a point 3 metres south of its junction with Wards Road.

2. Banbury Road:

(a) North west side - from its junction with Over Norton Road north eastwards to a point 15.5 metres north east of its junction with Banbury Road Crossing.

(b) South east side - from its junction with London Road north eastwards to a point 8.5 metres south west of its junction with Banbury Road Crossing.

3. Burford Road:

(a) East and north east sides - from its junction with West Street south eastwards to a point 3.4 metres south east of the boundary between

Nos. 67 and 69 Burford Road.

(b) West side:

- (i) from its junction with West Street south eastwards for a distance of 137 metres;
- (ii) from a point 2 metres south of the southern flank wall of No. 59 Burford Road south eastwards to a point 15.5 metres south of its junction with Walterbush Road.

4. Cattle Market:

(a) North side – the whole length.

(b) South side:

- (i) from its junction with Market Place eastwards for a distance of 15 metres;
- (ii) from a point 31 metres east of its junction with Market Place eastwards for 12.5 metres;
- (iii) from a point 49.5 metres east of its junction with Market Place eastwards to its junction with Albion Street.

5. Churchill Road:

(a) North west side:

- (i) from its junction with West End south westwards to a point 15 metres south west of its junction with Edward Stone Rise.
from a point 10 metres north east of the north eastern kerb line of Lords Piece Road south westwards to a point 20.5 metres south west of the south western kerb line of Lords Piece Road;
- (ii) from a point 45 metres north east of the north eastern kerb line of Tilsley Road south westwards to a point 17 metres south west of the south western kerb line of Tilsley Road.

(b) Lay-bys on the north west side:

- (i) from a point 27 metres south west of the south-western kerb line of Lords Piece Road south westwards for a distance of 10.5 metres;
- (ii) from a point 48 metres south west of the south-western kerb line of Lords Piece Road south westwards for a distance of 10 metres;
- (iii) from a point 64.5 metres south west of the south-western kerb line of Lords Piece Road south westwards for a distance of 4.5 metres.

(c) Southeast side:

- (i) from its junction with West End south westwards for a distance of 42.5 metres;
- (ii) from a point 57 metres south west of its junction with West End south westwards to a point 49.5 metres north of its junction with Edward Stone Rise;
- (iii) from a point 29.5 metres north east of its junction with Edward Stone Rise south westwards to a point 15 metres south west of the same junction;
- (iv) from a point opposite 10 metres north east of the north eastern kerb line of Lords Piece Road south westwards to a point opposite 16 metres south west of the south western kerb line of Lords Piece Road;
- (v) from a point 21 metres north east of the north eastern kerb line of Hailey Road south westwards to a point 41 metres south west of the south western kerb line of Hailey Road.

6. Church Lane:

- (a) North side – from its junction with Spring Street westwards for a distance of 31 metres.
- (b) South side – from its junction with Spring Street westwards for a distance of 15 metres.

7. Church Street:

- (a) North side – the whole length.
- (b) South side:
 - (i) from its junction with Spring Street westwards for a distance of 39.5 metres;
 - (ii) from a point 92 metres west of its junction with Spring Street westwards for a distance of 15 metres;
 - (iii) from a point 124 metres west of its junction with Spring Street westwards for a distance of 7 metres.

8. Cromwell Business Park Access Road (off Banbury Road)

- (a) Eastern side – from its junction with A361 Banbury Road south and south-eastwards for 73 metres to the gated access to Cromwell Park.
- (b) Southern side – from the gated access to Cromwell Park westwards and south-westwards for 64 metres to the gated access to Chipping Norton Highway Depot.
- (c) Western side – from the gated access to Chipping Norton Highway Depot north-eastwards and north-westwards for 111 metres to its junction with A361 Banbury Road.

9. Cross Leys:

- (a) Both sides - from its junction with The Leys north eastwards for a distance of 11 metres.
- (b) East side - from a point 13.5 metres south west of its junction with Leys Approach north eastwards to a point 13 metres north east of that junction.

10. Dunstan Avenue:

(a) East side:

- (i) from its junction with New Street southwards for a distance of 48 metres;
- (ii) from a point 70 metres south of its junction with New Street southwards to a point 40.5 metres south of its junction with Withers Way.

(b) West side:

- (i) from its junction with New Street southwards to a point 73 metres north of its junction with Withers Way;
- (ii) from a point 42 metres north of its junction with Withers Way southwards for a distance of 82.5 metres.

11. Edward Stone Rise:

Both sides - from its junction with Churchill Road southwards for a distance of 8 metres.

12. Fox Close:

- (a) North side - from its junction with Albion Street eastwards for a distance of 34 metres.
- (b) South side - from its junction with Albion Street eastwards for a distance of 9 metres.

13. Goddards Lane:

(a) Both sides:

- (i) from its junction with High Street westwards for a distance of 33.5 metres;
- (ii) from its junction with Market Street eastwards for a distance of 7.5 metres.

14. Hailey Avenue:

Both sides - from its junction with Walterbush Avenue north westwards for a distance of 10 metres.

15. Hailey Crescent:

Both sides - from its junction with Walterbush Avenue north westwards for a distance of 6 metres.

16. Hailey Road:

- (a) Both sides - from its junction with Walterbush Avenue north westwards for a distance of 10.5 metres.
- (b) North east side - from the south eastern kerb line of Churchill Road south eastwards for a distance of 18 metres.
- (c) South west side - from the south eastern kerb line of Churchill Road south eastwards for a distance of 21 metres.

17. High Street:

(a) East side:

- (i) from its junction with Cattle Market northwards for a distance of 5.5 metres;
- (ii) from a point 17 metres north of its junction with Cattle Market northwards for a distance of 19 metres;
- (iii) from a point 88 metres north of its junction with Cattle Market northwards for a distance of 15 metres;
- (iv) from a point 118 metres north of its junction with Cattle Market northwards to a point 119 metres south of its junction with Horsefair;
- (v) from its junction with Horse Fair southwards for a distance of 72 metres.

(b) West side:

- (i) from a point 3 metres north of the southern flank wall of the Town Hall northwards for a distance of 21.5 metres;
- (ii) from a point 43 metres north of the southern flank wall of the Town Hall northwards for a distance of 10 metres;
- (iii) from a point 60 metres north of the southern flank wall of the Town Hall northwards for a distance of 10 metres;
- (iv) from a point 76 metres north of the southern flank wall of the Town Hall northwards for a distance of 16.5 metres;
- (v) from a point 99 metres north of the southern flank wall of the Town Hall northwards for a distance of 56.5 metres.

- (c) West side (A44) – from its junction with Horse Fair southwards to its junction with Market Place (A44).

18. Horse Fair:

- (a) East side:
 - (i) from its junction with High Street northwards for a distance of 27.5 metres;
 - (ii) from its junction with London Road southwards for a distance of 46 metres.
- (b) West side - from its junction with High Street northwards to its junction with Over Norton Road.

19. Leys Approach:

- (a) North east side – the whole length.
- (b) South west side:
 - (i) from its junction with Cross Leys south eastwards for a distance of 8.5 metres;
 - (ii) from a point 47.5 metres north west of its junction with West End north westwards for a distance of 10 metres;
 - (iii) from a point 34.5 metres north west of its junction with West End north westwards for a distance of 6.5 metres;
 - (iv) from its junction with West End north westwards for a distance of 14 metres.

20. London Road:

- (a) North side
 - (i) from its junction with Banbury Road eastwards to a point 41.5 metres east of its junction with Summerton Place;
 - (i) from a point 18 metres west of the eastern kerb line of Rockhill Farm Court eastwards for a distance of 62 metres.
- (b) South side - from its junction with Banbury Road eastwards to a point 41.5 metres west of its junction with Summerton Place.

21. Lords Piece Road:

Both sides - from the north western kerb line of Churchill Road north westwards for a distance of 7 metres.

22. Market Place:

- (a) Main route (A361/A44) - both sides - from its junction with West Street north eastwards to its junction with High Street.
- (b) Minor arm west of Town Hall on the west side of Market Place car park:
 - (i) East side - from its southern termination northwards for a distance of 64.5 metres, including the turning area.

- (ii) West side - from its southern termination northwards to a point 4 metres south of its junction with Market Street.
- (c) Northern arm on north side of Market Place Car Park – the whole length including the section at its junction with the Minor Carriageway west of Town Hall on the west side of Market Place car park.
- (d) Southern arm (on south side of Town Hall):
 - (i) North side – from its junction with the main carriageway of Market Place eastwards for a distance of 7 metres;
 - (ii) South side – the whole length.

23. Market Street:

- (a) East side - from its junction with Goddards Lane southwards for a distance of 56 metres.
- (b) West side - from its junction with Church Street southwards for a distance of 33.5 metres.

24. Middle Row:

- (a) Carriageway on south and east side of Guildhall - both sides - the whole length.
- (b) The Pedestrianised area north of its junction with Market Place - the whole length.

25. New Street:

- (a) North side - from its junction with Market Place westwards to a point 97 metres west of its junction with Dunstan Avenue.
- (b) South side:
 - (i) from its junction with Market Place westwards for a distance of 27.5 metres;
 - (ii) from a point 74.5 metres west of its junction with Market Place westwards for a distance of 61.5 metres;
 - (iii) from a point 36 metres west of its junction with Dunstan Avenue eastwards for a distance of 97 metres.

26. Over Norton Road:

- (a) East side - from its junction with Banbury Road northwards to a point 54 metres north of its junction with Spring Street
- (b) West side:
 - (i) from its junction with Horse Fair northwards for a distance of 20 metres excluding the lay-by;
 - (ii) from a point 34 metres south of its junction with Spring Street northwards to a point 54 metres north of that junction.

- (iii) from a point 27 metres south of the southern kerb line of Wilcox Road northwards to a point 27 metres north of the northern kerb line of Wilcox Road.

27. Rock Hill:

- (a) Both sides - from its junction with Albion Street eastwards for a distance of 33.5 metres.
- (b) Lay-by/turning area (adjoining No. 46) - from a point 3.5 metres east of the eastern flank wall of No. 46 Rock Hill eastwards for a distance of 16 metres.

28. Rockhill Farm Court (Cul-de-Sac):

All sides - throughout their entire length

29. Rowell Way:

- (a) North side - from its junction with Albion Street eastwards to its junction with Shepard Way.
- (b) South side - from its junction with Albion Street eastwards to a point 8 metres east of its junction with Shepard Way.

30. Spring Street:

(a) East and south side:

- (i) from its junction with Goddards Lane northwards for a distance of 44.5 metres;
- (ii) from a point 12 metres north east of its junction with Church Lane northwards for a distance of 14.5 metres;
- (iii) from its junction with Over Norton Road westwards and south westwards for a distance of 60.5 metres.

(b) West side and north side:

- (i) from its junction with Church Street northwards for a distance of 41 metres;
- (ii) from its junction with Church Lane northwards and eastwards to a point 26.5 metres west of its junction with Over Norton Road;
- (iii) from its junction with Over Norton Road westwards for a distance of 13.5 metres.

31. Station Road:

Both sides - from a point 80 metres south west of its eastern junction with Worcester Road south eastwards and south westwards to a point 64.5 metres south west of its junction with Lewis Road.

32. The Green:

(a) North side:

- (i) from its junction with West Street south eastwards for a distance of 23.5 metres;
- (ii) from a point 54 metres south east of its junction with West Street south eastwards for a distance of 27 metres;
- (iii) from its junction with Walterbush Road north westwards for a distance of 76.5 metres.

(b) South side - the whole length.

33. The Leys:

(a) North east side - from its junction with Churchill Road north westwards to a point 7 metres north west of its junction with Cross Leys.

(b) Southwest side:

- (i) from its junction with Churchill Road north westwards for a distance of 15 metres;
- (ii) from a point 42 metres north west of its junction with Churchill Road north westwards for a distance of 5 metres;
- (iii) from its northern junction with Alexander Square north westwards for a distance of 9 metres.

34. Tilsley Road:

Both sides - from the north western kerb line of Churchill Road north westwards for a distance of 8 metres.

35. Walterbush Road:

(a) Northwest side:

- (i) from its junction with Burford Road south westwards to a point 26 metres south west of its junction with The Green;
- (ii) from a point 16 metres north east of its junction with Hailey Avenue south westwards to a point 13.5 metres south west of the same junction;
- (iii) from a point 14 metres north east of its junction with Hailey Crescent south westwards to a point 14 metres south west of the same junction;
- (iv) from a point 14.5 metres northeast of the centre-line of Hailey Road south westwards to a point 25 metres south west of the centre-line of Hailey Road.

- (b) Southeast side - from its junction with Burford Road south westwards to a point 29.5 metres south of its junction with Cotswold Crescent.

36. West End:

Both sides - the whole length.

37. West Street:

(a) East and south east side:

- (i) from a point 13 metres north of its junction with Burford Road southwards to a point 47 metres south of that junction;
- (ii) from a point 64.5 metres north east of its junction with The Green north eastwards for a distance of 90 metres;
- (iii) from its junction with West End north eastwards to a point 51 metres north east of its junction with The Green.

(b) West and north west side:

- (i) from its junction with Market Place southwards for a distance of 27.5 metres;
- (ii) from a point 57.5 south of its junction with Market Place southwards to a point 25.5 metres south of its junction with Burford Road;
- (iii) from a point 43.5 metres north east of its junction with West End north eastwards to a point 80.5 metres south west of its junction with Burford Road;
- (iv) from its junction with West End north eastwards for a distance of 28.5 metres.

38. Wilcox Road:

Both sides - from the western kerb line of Over Norton Road westwards for a distance of 10 metres."
