OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS – WEST OXFORDSHIRE) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PERMITTED PARKING) (VARIATION No.35) ORDER 2025

Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 & 45 and Part IV Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads West Oxfordshire) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Permitted Parking) (Variation No.35) Order 2025 and shall come into force on the 30th day of June 2025.
- (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
 - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.
 - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.

 - (ii) from a point 65.5 metres north east of the north eastern kerb line of Sheep Street north eastwards for a distance of 11 metres
- East side from a point 2 metres north of the north eastern flank wall
 of No. 25 Priory Lane south westwards to a point 10 metres south west
 of the rear access to the commercial premises in High Street;
- d) North side from a point 39 metres west of the western kerb line of the High Street westwards for a distance of 44 metres.
- e) South side from a point 25 metres west of the western kerb line of the High Street westwards for a distance of 20 metres.
- f) West, North and West side from a point 65.5 metres northeast of the north eastern kerb line of Sheep Street north eastwards, eastwards and north-eastwards again to a point 17 metres west of the common property boundary of Burford Primary School & The Rectory.

- b) South side:
 - (i) from the western kerb line of the High Street north westwards for a distance of 15 metres:
 - (ii) from a point 32 metres north west of the western kerb line of the High Street north westwards for a distance of 9 metres;
 - (iii) from a point 1.5 metres east of the boundary between Nos. 11 and 17 Sheep Street westwards for a distance of 6 metres;
 - (iv) from a point 4 metres west of the western boundary of No. 17 Sheep Street westwards for a distance of 5 metres;
 - (v) from a point 1.5 metres east of the boundary between Nos. 25 and 27 Sheep Street westwards for a distance of 7 metres;
