THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (HARCOURT HILL, NORTH HINKSEY) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2001

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following order:

1. In this Order, so far as the context so admits:

"road" includes part of a road;

"disabled person's badge", "disabled person's parking disc", "disabled person's vehicle" and "relevant position" shall be construed in accordance with the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations, 2000.

- Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit:
 - (a) a vehicle to wait in the length of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary:-
 - (i) for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (ii) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle:
 - (iii) to enable goods or other burden to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (iv) to enable the vehicle, if it is in the service of or employed by the Post Office, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act, 1953;
 - (v) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any wedding, funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (vi) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or
 - (vii) to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the road;

- (b) a vehicle being a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge to wait for a period not exceeding three hours in the length of road referred to in the said Article 2 (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road on the same day) provided that the vehicle displays also in the relevant position a disabled person's parking disc on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting
- 4. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Harcourt Hill, North Hinksey) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2001 and shall come into operation on 24 January 2001.

SCHEDULE NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

Harcourt Hill, North Hinksey, both sides, from its junction with Westminster Way for a distance of 808 metres generally eastwards then southwards.
