ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (THE WATERSIDE, OXFORD) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE) (VARIATION No.2) ORDER 2007

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 30th April 2007 and may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (The Waterside, Oxford) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Amendment) Order 2007.
- 2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
 - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.
 - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
- The City of Oxford (The Waterside) (Controlled Parking Zone) Order 2001 ("The 2001 Order") as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford) (The Waterside) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation No.1) Order 2007, is amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 4. The Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford) (The Waterside) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Amendment) Order 2007 is revoked and replaced by this order.

SCHEDULE

Amendments to "The 2001 Order":

1. The following is inserted after Article 26:

"PART V One-way Streets

26A No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the road specified in column 1 of Schedule 5 to the Order, other than in the direction specified in column 2 of that Schedule, provided that it shall not be in contravention of this restriction for a person who wishes to use any parking place in, or adjacent to such road, to manoeuvre into or out of the parking place by means of forward and reverse gears."

- 2. Article 28 is deleted and replaced by the following:
 - "28 the Order specified in Schedule 6 to this Order is revoked".
- Part V and Part VI of the Waterside Order are re-designated Part VI and VII respectively.
- The following is inserted after Schedule 4:

" SCHEDULE 5 One-Way Streets

Column 1

Column 2 (Permitted direction)

Merrivale Square from its junction with Rutherway

In such direction as to keep the centre island of Merrivale Square on the right hand side of the vehicle"

Schedule 5 (Part VI of the Order) is re-designated Schedule 6 (Part VII of the Order).
