ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WALTON MANOR OXFORD) (PARKING PLACES AND TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION NO.7) ORDER 2009

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of their powers under sections 32, 35, 45 and 46 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

- This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Walton Manor Oxford) (Parking Places and Traffic Management) (Consolidation) (Variation No.7) Order 2009 and shall come into force on 9th March 2009.
- (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment
 - (2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment
 - (3) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall unless the context otherwise requires be construed as a reference to the numbered Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Walton Manor, Oxford) (Parking Places and Traffic Management) (Consolidation) Order 2003 ("the 2003 Order") as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford) (Walton Manor, Oxford) (Parking Places and Traffic Management) (Consolidation) (Variation No.1) Order 2005, the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford) (Walton Manor, Oxford) (Parking Places and Traffic Management) (Consolidation) (Variation No.2) Order 2006, the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford) (Walton Manor, Oxford) (Parking Places and Traffic Management) (Consolidation) (Variation No.3) Order 2006, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Walton Manor, Oxford) (Parking Places and Traffic Management) (Variation No.4) Order 2007, the Oxfordshire County Council (Walton Manor, Oxford) (Parking Places and Traffic Management) (Consolidation) (Variation No.5) Order 2008 and the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford & North Hinksey) (Traffic Management Act 2004 - Consequential Provisions) Order 2008, is amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- The Oxfordshire County Council (Walton Manor, Oxford) (Parking Places and Traffic Management) (Consolidation) (Variation No.5) Order 2008 is hereby revoked.


