THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS STREETS EAST OXFORD) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (VARIATION No.5) ORDER 2009

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) & 2(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act make the following Order:

This order shall be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Streets East Oxford) (Traffic Regulation) (Variation No.5) Order 2009 and shall come into force on the first day of June 2009.

- (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
 - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.
 - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
- 2. The Oxfordshire County Council (Various Streets East Oxford) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2002 ("the 2002 Order") as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (Cowley Road, Oxford) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2005, the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Streets East Oxford) (Traffic Regulation) (Variation No.1) Order 2007, the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford and North Hinksey) (Traffic Management Act 2004 Consequential Provisions) Order 2008, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Streets East Oxford) (Traffic Regulation) (Variation No.4) Order 2009 shall be amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Amendment to "the 2002 Order":

1.

In Schedule 2 No Waiting at Any Time, delete item 20 (g) Iffley Road and replace as follows:

"20.

Iffley Road

(g) North-eastern side, from a point 18 metres northwest of the north-western kerb line of Howard Street, south-eastwards to a point 60 metres southeast of the a south-eastern kerb line of Howard Street;

including the access road to Nos.299a -299c Iffley Road, northwards for a distance of 15 metres on both sides of the road."

In Schedule 2 – insert new paragraph (i) into item 20 Iffley Road as follows:

"20

Iffley Road

(i) Southwest side, from a point 9 metres southeast of its junction with Bullingdon Road, southwards to a point level with the eastern boundary of No 298 lffley Road, south-east of Addison Crescent."
