

**THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(OXFORD CENTRAL AREA) (DESIGNATION AND REGULATION OF
STREET PARKING PLACES) (VARIATION NO.4) ORDER 2009**

The Oxfordshire County Council, ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 45 to 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part II of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 21st September 2009 and may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Central Area) (Designation and Regulation of Street Parking Places) (Variation No.4) Order 2009.
2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
(2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations.
3. The Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Central Area) (Designation and Regulation of Street Parking Places) Order 2002 ("the 2002 Order"), as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Central Area) (Designation and Regulation of Street Parking Places) (Variation No.1) Order 2004, the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Central Area) (Designation and Regulation of Street Parking Places) (Variation No.2) Order 2005, and the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford and North Hinksey) (Traffic Management Act 2004 - Consequential Provisions) Order 2008, is hereby amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.
