

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PAY-AND-DISPLAY PARKING, OXFORD CITY) (VARIATION NO.2) ORDER 2009

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 45 to 53 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 16 November 2009 and may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Pay-and-Display Parking, Oxford City) (Variation No.2) Order 2009.
2.
 - (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
 - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.
 - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
3. The Oxfordshire County Council (Pay-and-Display Parking, Oxford City) Order 2002 ("the 2002 Order") as amended by Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford and North Hinksey - Traffic Management Act 2004) (Consequential Provisions) Order 2008, is amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.


SCHEDULE

Amendment to "the 2002 Order" – **FIRST SCHEDULE, Designated Parking Places, Part I (Charging Hours 8.00 a.m – 6.30 p.m Mondays to Fridays and 8.00 a.m – 1.00 p.m Saturdays)**

In Item 5 Norham Road, delete sub-item (a) and insert as follows:

"(a) Northern side; from a point 25 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Banbury Road, eastwards for a distance of 71 metres."
