THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES - OXFORD) ORDER 2010

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers contained in Sections 32, 35 and 45 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

PARTI

IMPLEMENTATION, CITATION DEFINITIONS AND CONSTRUCTION

- This Order may be cited as The Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places - Oxford) Order 2010 and shall come into operation on the first day of November 2010.
- 2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the following meanings:

"Civil Enforcement Officer" means a person authorised under Section 76 Traffic Management Act 2004 (the "TMA") to undertake enforcement of parking contraventions (as defined in the TMA) and a parking attendant authorised under Section 63A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to supervise and enforce these restrictions imposed by any of the provisions of this Order is a Civil Enforcement Officer;

"Disabled Persons Badge" has the meaning given in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

"Disabled Persons Parking Places" means the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order, and authorised to be used as parking places for Disabled Persons Vehicles (and otherwise) as provided by Article 4 of this Order:

"Disabled Persons Vehicle" means:

- (a) a vehicle lawfully displaying in the Relevant Position a Disabled Persons Badge; and
- (b) a vehicle lawfully displaying a Recognised Badge;

"Driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a Disabled Persons Parking Place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left there;

"Parking Orders" means those Order listed in Schedule 6 to this Order;

"Penalty Charge" means a penalty charge imposed further to Part 6 of "the TMA" and set by the Council further to paragraph 3 of Schedule 9 to that Act;

"Penalty Charge Notice" means a notice issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer pursuant to regulations made further to Part 6 of "the TMA";

"Postal Packet" means a letter, parcel, packet or other article transmitted by post-

"Prescribed Hours" means the period between 8.00am and 6.30pm Monday to Saturday inclusive;

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"Recognised Badge" has the meaning given in Section 21 A of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970;

"Relevant Position" means for the display of a Disabled Persons Badge displayed in the manner prescribed by Regulation 12 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

"Traffic Sign" means any object, device, line or mark for conveying/or notifying to traffic on roads or any specified class of traffic warnings, information, requirements, restrictions or prohibitions as specified in Section 64 of the Act;

"Universal Service Provider" has the meaning given in Sections 4(3) and (4) of the Postal Services Act 2000.

Any reference in any Order to a "Parking Attendant" or "parking attendant" shall take effect as if it was a reference to a Civil Enforcement Officer.

- (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment;
 - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa;
 - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment;
 - (4) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall unless the context otherwise requires be construed as a reference to the numbered Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order;
 - (5) Headings are inserted for convenience and shall not affect the construction or interpretation of this Order:
 - (6) Where this Order repeals an order which in turn repealed a previous order, the repeal contained in this Order does not revive any order previously repealed unless express words are added reviving it.

PARTII

DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES

Authorisation of Parking Places

- 4. (1) Each of the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order are authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Part of this Order, as a parking place only for the classes of vehicles specified in Article 4(4).
 - (2) No vehicle, other than of a class specified in Article 4(4) shall park at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedules 1 to 4 to this Order.
 - (3) No vehicle other than of a class specified in Article 4(4) shall park during the Prescribed Hours in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 5 to this Order.
 - (4) The classes of vehicles referred to in this Article 4 are:

(i) a Disabled Persons Vehicle;

(ii) a vehicle being used for any purpose specified in Article 12 of this Order.

Time Restricted Waiting

- (1) Save as provided in Article 12, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer, the Council or a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any Disabled Persons Vehicle to wait during the Prescribed Hours, in any length of road specified in Schedule 5 to this Order:
 - (a) for a period longer than 3 hours; or
 - (b) if a period of less than 1 hour has elapsed since the termination during the Prescribed Hours of the last period of parking (if any) of the vehicle in the same Disabled Persons Parking Place
 - (2) Where a vehicle, having been left in a Disabled Persons Parking Place remains there at the beginning of the Prescribed Hours, then the vehicle will be treated as if it had arrived in the Disabled Persons Parking Place at the beginning of the Prescribed Hours.

Position in which a Vehicle may stand

- 6. The driver of a vehicle of a class specified in Article 4(4) shall not permit it to wait in a Disabled Persons Parking Place unless it is standing in position in single line with every part of the vehicle on the carriageway and so that the whole nearside or offside of the vehicle is adjacent to the kerb, unless otherwise specified in the Schedules to this Order.
- 7. The limits of each Disabled Persons Parking Place shall be indicated by the Council on the carriageway by the appropriate Traffic Signs and any vehicle standing in a Disabled Persons Parking Place shall stand wholly within the limits so marked.

Restrictions on Use

- 8. The driver of a vehicle using a Disabled Persons Parking Place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the Disabled Persons Parking Place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in, or to depart from the Disabled Persons Parking Place.
- No person shall use any vehicle while it is in a Disabled Persons Parking Place in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near it or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.

Removal and Moving of Vehicles

- 10. (1) If the Council, a Civil Enforcement Officer or a police constable in uniform is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in this Part of this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in a Disabled Persons Parking Place he may:
 - (a) alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle to comply with the provisions; or
 - (b) remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the Disabled Persons Parking Place and, where it is to be removed, he will make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.

- (2) The Council, a Civil Enforcement Officer or a police officer in uniform may, in case of emergency, move or cause to be moved to any place he thinks fit any vehicle left in a Disabled Persons Parking Place.
- (3) Any person authorised to remove a vehicle or alter its position by virtue Article 10(1) or 10(2) may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.

Suspension of Use of Disabled Persons Parking Place

- 11. (1) The Council, a Civil Enforcement Officer or a police officer in uniform may suspend the use of a Disabled Persons Parking Place or any part of it whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary:
 - (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to such a parking place;
 - (c) for works to the road (including but not by way of limitation cleansing of gulleys and installation of traffic signs) in or adjacent to such a parking place;
 - (d) for the laying, erection, alteration, removal, repair or servicing in or adjacent to such a parking place of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water electricity or communications services;
 - (e) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the Disabled Persons Parking Place for of the removal of furniture or household effects to or from a shop, office, or dwelling house, or depository;
 - (f) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any road will be thronged or obstructed, or
 - (g) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the Disabled Persons Parking Place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.
 - (2) Any person suspending the use of a Disabled Persons Parking Place or any part of it in accordance with the provisions of Article 11(1) shall place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that Disabled Persons Parking Place or the part of it whose use is suspended a traffic sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.
 - (3) Save as provided in Article 11(4) no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in a Disabled Persons Parking Place or part of a Disabled Persons Parking Place during any period when there is in, or adjacent to that Disabled Persons Parking Place or part of it, a traffic sign placed pursuant to Article 11(2).
 - (4) Nothing in Article 11(3) will apply to any vehicle waiting for so long only as may be necessary:
 - (a) if the vehicle is being used for the relevant purpose or eventuality specified in Article 11 (1)(b) (building works), 11 (1)(c) (road works), 11 (1)(d) (works to services), 11 (1)(e) (furniture removal) or 11 (1)(g) (wedding or funeral) for which use of the Parking Place (or part of it) was suspended;

- (b) to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
- (c) if a vehicle is being used for police fire or ambulance purposes;
- (d) if the vehicle is waiting while any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged is being opened or closed, if it is not reasonably practicable for the vehicle to wait otherwise than in that parking place or part of it while such gate or other barrier is being opened or closed;
- (e) if the vehicle is waiting because the person in control of it is required by law to stop or is obliged to do so to avoid an accident or is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control; or
- (f) if the vehicle is being used for any other purpose and the prior permission of the Council, a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer has been obtained.

provided that the person in control of the vehicle must move it on the instruction of a police constable in uniform whenever that police constable considers this necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction.

Exemptions

- 12. Notwithstanding the above provisions of this Part of the Order a vehicle may wait in a Disabled Persons Parking place, other than a parking place the use of which has been suspended, if the vehicle is:
 - (1) an ambulance being used for ambulance purposes;
 - (2) in the service of the fire brigade and being used for fire brigade purposes;
 - (3) a police vehicle being used for police purposes;
 - (4) in the service of a local authority and being used for carrying out statutory functions but for so long only as is required to enable the vehicle to be so used;
 - (5) in the service of or employed by a Universal Service Provider while in use for the purpose of loading, unloading, delivering or collecting Postal Packets at premises or posting boxes adjacent to the parking place;
 - (6) waiting while any gate or other barrier at the entrance to land or premises to which the vehicle requires access or from which it has emerged is being opened or closed, if it is not reasonably practicable for the vehicle to wait otherwise than in the parking place while such gate or other barrier is being opened or closed;
 - (7) waiting in any case where the person in control of the vehicle is required by law to stop, or is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident or is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control;
 - (8) being used in connection with any of the following and cannot conveniently be so used without waiting in the parking place, but for so long only as is required to enable the vehicle to be so used:

(a) removing any obstruction to traffic at or adjoining that road;

(b) undertaking works (including inspection) in relation to that road or to a traffic sign, street lighting or street furniture at or adjoining that road;

 (c) undertaking works (including inspection) in relation to a sewer or water main or in relation to the supply of gas, electricity, water or communication services in or adjoining that road;

(d) a funeral associated with premises at or adjoining that road and is a hearse or other official vehicle of an undertaker.

provided that in any of the cases mentioned above the person in control of the vehicle shall move it on the instruction of a police officer in uniform wherever this shall be necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction.

Contravention

- 13. (1) If a parking contravention (as defined in the Traffic Management Act 2004) is committed in contravention of any of the provisions of this order, a Penalty Charge will be payable.
 - (2) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a Penalty Charge is payable, a Penalty Charge Notice may be issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer.

PART III

VARIATIONS

14. In the Articles to each of the Parking Orders, the definition of 'Disabled Persons Parking Places Order' is deleted and replaced by the following:

"Disabled Persons Parking Places Order" means the Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places -Oxford) (Consolidation) Order 20** as amended from time to time."

15. The Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places - Oxford) Order 2007, as amended ("the 2007 Order") is hereby revoked, but for the avoidance of doubt the variations and revocations contained in Part III of the 2007 Order shall remain force.
