

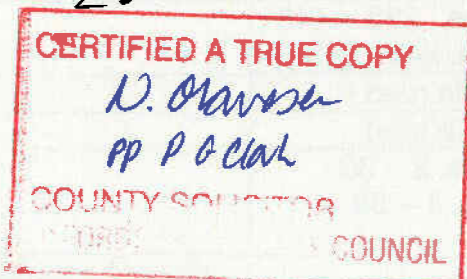
**THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (MARSTON SOUTH)
(CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS)
(VARIATION No.3) ORDER 2010**

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32(1), 35(1), 45 & 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order

This Order shall may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Marston South) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) (Variation No.3) Order 2010 and will come into operation on the first day of November 2010

1.
 - (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment
 - (2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment
 - (3) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.
 - (4) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article shall unless the context otherwise requires be construed as a reference to the numbered Article bearing that number in this Order.
2. The Oxfordshire County Council (Marston South) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) Order 2007, as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford and North Hinksey) (Traffic Management Act 2004 - Consequential Provisions) Order 2008, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Marston South) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) (Variation No.2 Order 2009 ("the 2007 Order"), is amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.
