# THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BRAKE HILL, OXFORD) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE) (VARIATION No.5) ORDER 2011

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) & (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Brake Hill) (Oxford) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation No.5) Order 2011 shall come into operation on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of November 2011.
- 2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the following meanings:
  - (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment
  - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa
  - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment
  - (4) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall unless the context otherwise requires be construed as a reference to the numbered Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 3. The Oxfordshire County Council (Brake Hill) (Oxford) (Controlled Parking Zone) Order 2005, as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places Oxford) Order 2007, the Oxfordshire County Council (Blackbird Leys West, Minchery Farm, Frys Hill and Brake Hill, Oxford) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation) Order 2007; the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford and North Hinksey) (Traffc Management Act 2004 Consequential Provisions) Order 2008, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places Oxford) Order 2010 ("the 2005 Order") is further amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.

## Length of Road

- 1. Brake Hill

  Both sides; From the north-western kerb line of Grenoble
  Road north-westwards for a distance of 69 metres.
- 2. Coriander Way

  (a) West side; From a point 7 metres north of the common property boundary of numbers 9 and 10 Coriander Way southwards for a distance of 14 metres.
  - (b) South side; From the common property boundary of number 2 Kingfisher Green and number 27 Coriander Way westwards to the common property boundary of numbers 25 and 27 Coriander Way an approximate distance of 11 metres.
- 3. Elder Way

Northeast side; From the common property boundary of number 2 Sage Walk and number 21 Elder Way southeastwards for a distance of 7 metres.

4. Kingfisher Green

South side; From the common property boundary of numbers 2 and 4 Kingfisher Green westwards to the common property boundary of number 2 Kingfisher Green and number 27 Coriander Way an approximate distance of 10 metres.

5. Sage Walk

Northeast side; From the common property boundary of numbers 2 and 4 Sage Walk south-eastwards to the common property boundary of number 2 Sage Walk and number 21 Elder Way an approximate distance of 9 metres.

- 6. Tarragon Drive
- (a) West side; From the northern kerb line of Grenoble Road to a point 25 metres north of the northern kerb line of Pochard Place.
- (b) East side; From the northern kerb line of Grenoble Road to a point 2 metres north of the northern kerb line of Teal Close."

Together with any Access Way and any Bus Stop Area in the lengths of Road specified in Schedule1".
