

**THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(MINCHERY FARM) (OXFORD) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE)  
(VARIATION No.5) ORDER 2011**

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) & (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Minchery Farm) (Oxford) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation No.5) Order 2011 and shall come into operation on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of November 2011.
2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the following meanings:
  - (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment
  - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa
  - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment
  - (4) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall unless the context otherwise requires be construed as a reference to the numbered Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. The Oxfordshire County Council (Minchery Farm) (Oxford) (Controlled Parking Zone) Order 2005; as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places - Oxford) Order 2007, the Oxfordshire County Council (Blackbird Leys West, Minchery Farm, Frys Hill and Brake Hill, Oxford) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation) Order 2007; the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford and North Hinksey) (Traffic Management Act 2004 – Consequential Provisions) Order 2008, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places - Oxford) Order 2010 ("the 2005 Order") is further amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.

## **SCHEDULE**

Schedule 2 to "the 2005 Order" is deleted and replaced as follows:

### **"SCHEDULE 2**

#### **RESTRICTED ROADS IN THE CITY OF OXFORD**

(No Waiting at Any Time)

<b>Road Name</b>	<b>Length of Road</b>
1. Carpenter Close	(a) Both sides; From the south-western kerb line of St Nicholas Road south-westwards for a distance of 10 metres.
2. Giles Road	(a) Northwest side; From the northern kerb line of St Nicholas Road northwards for a distance of 45 metres. (b) Southeast side; From the northern kerb line of St Nicholas Road northwards for a distance of 29 metres.
3. Grange Road	(a) Both sides; From the south-western kerb line of St Nicholas Road south-westwards for a distance of 15 metres. (b) Southeast side; From a point 10 metres northeast of the north-eastern kerb line of Minchery Road south-westwards to the common property boundary of no. 21 Grange Road and Lawn Upton Middle School.
4. Lakefield Road.	Both sides; From the south-western kerb line of Minchery Road south-westwards for a distance of 15 metres.
6. Minchery Road - Access road between Nos.5 & 7 Minchery Road	(a) Southeast side; From the north-eastern kerb line Minchery Road north-eastwards for a distance of 4 metres.
Minchery Road	(b) Both sides; From a point 10 metres northwest of the north-western kerb line of Lakefield Road to a point 10 metres southeast of the south-eastern kerb line of Lakefield Road. (c) Both sides, From a point 10 metres southwest of the south-western kerb line of St Nicholas Road to a point 10 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb line of St Nicholas Road. (d) Northeast sides; From the south-eastern kerb line of the access road between No. 5 and No. 7 Minchery Road to the common boundary of Nos. 7 and 9 Minchery Road. (e) Northeast side; From the south-eastern kerb line of Grange Road south-eastwards for a distance of 10 metres.

- (f) Southwest side; From the south-eastern kerb line of Grange Road south-eastwards for a distance of 20 metres.
5. Priory Road Both sides; From the north-eastern kerb line of St Nicholas Road north-eastwards for a distance of 18 metres.
6. St Nicholas Road
- (a) Both sides; From the north-western kerb line of Minchery Road north-westwards for a distance of 20 metres
- (b) North side; From a point 11 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Giles Road westwards for a distance of 30 metres
- (c) Northeast side; From a point 15 metres northwest of the north-western kerb line of Priory Road south-eastwards to a point 10 metres southeast of the south-eastern kerb line of Priory Road.
- (d) Southwest side; From a point 7 metres northwest of the common property boundary of numbers 52/54 St Nicholas Road westwards for a distance of 64 metres.
- (e) Southwest side; from a point 16 metres southeast of the south-eastern kerb line of Carpenter Close north-westwards to a point 28 metres northwest of the north-western kerb line of Carpenter Close.

Together with any Access Way and any Bus Stop Area in the lengths of Road specified in Schedule 1".
