

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES - OXFORD)
(VARIATION NO.4) ORDER 2012**

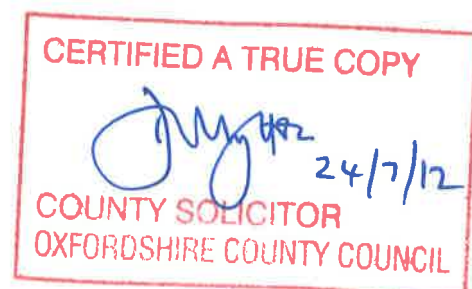
The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers contained in Sections 1(1), 2(2), (4), 32, 35 and 45 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places - Oxford) (Variation No.4) Order 2012 and shall come into operation on the 23 day of July 2012.
2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment

(2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa

(3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
3. The Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places - Oxford) Order 2010 as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places - Oxford) (Variation No.1) Order 2011, the Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places - Oxford) (Variation No. 2) Order 2011, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places - Oxford) (Variation No. 3) Order 2012 ("the 2010 Order"), is amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the schedule to this order.

8.	Cardigan Street		North-west side; from a point 32 metres south-west of the south-western kerblines of Albert Street, south-westwards for a distance of 6 metres. Outside 61/62 Cardigan Street.
9.	Cranham Street	(a)	Northwest side; from a point 8 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb line of Canal Street, north-eastwards for a distance of 6 metres. Outside 44 Cranham Street.
		(b)	Northwest side; from a point 3.6 metres north-east of the common property boundary between No's 51 & 52, north-eastwards for a distance of 6.6 metres. Outside No 53 Cranham Street.
10.	Floyd's Row		South side; from a point 14 metres east of the eastern kerblines of St Aldates, eastwards for a distance of 12 metres. Adjacent to the Police Station.
11.	Friars Wharf		West side; from a point adjacent to the northern kerblines of Friars Wharf, northwards for a distance of 6.6 metres. Adjacent to the rear of 20 Friars Wharf.
12.	Great Clarendon Street		North-west side; from a point 21 metres south-west of the south-western kerb line of Walton Street, north-eastwards for a distance of 11 metres. Outside the Post Office.
13.	Hart Street		South-west side; from a point 8 metres north-west of the north-western kerb line of Cardigan Street, north-westwards for 6.6 metres.
14.	High Street	(a)	North side; from a point 16 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Queens Lane, eastwards for a distance of 15 metres.
		(b)	North side; from a point 39.4 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Turl Street, eastwards for a distance of 14 metres.

15.	Jowett Walk	North side; from a point 14 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Mansfield Road, eastwards for a distance of 6.6 metres.	
16.	Juxon Street	North side; from a point 68 metres west of the western kerb line of Walton Street, westwards for a distance of 6 metres. Outside No 59 Juxon Street.	
17.	Keble Road	North side; from a point 17 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Banbury Road, eastwards for a distance of 20 metres.	
18.	Kingston Road	(a)	East side; from a point 8 metres south of the southern kerb line of Polstead Road, southwards for a distance of 6 metres.
		(b)	East side; from a point 3.5 metres south of the common property boundary between No's 148 & 149, southwards for a distance of 6.6 metres. Outside 149 & 150 Kingston Road.
19.	Littlegate Street	West side; from a point 5 metres south of the southern kerb line of Turn Again Lane, southwards for a distance of 28 metres.	
20.	Merton Street	South side; from a point 129 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Magpie Lane, eastwards for a distance of 6.6 metres.	
21.	Nelson Street	South side; from a point 18 metres west of the western kerb line of Walton Crescent westwards for a distance of 10 metres. Outside No 10 & 11 Nelson Street.	
22.	New Inn Hall Street	(a)	East side; from a point 17 metres south of the southern kerb line of George Street, southwards for a distance of 12 metres.
		(b)	East side; from a point 10 metres south of the southern kerb line of St. Michael's Street, southwards for a distance of 43.5 metres.
		(c)	East side; from a point 72 metres south of the southern kerb line of St. Michael's Street, southwards for a distance of 25 metres.
23.	New Road	North-eastern side; from a point 57 metres north-west of the western kerb line of Castle Street, north-westwards for a distance of 30 metres.	

24.	Observatory Street	Northwest side; from a point 78 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb line of Adelaide Street, north-eastwards for a distance of 12 metres. Outside Belsyre Court.	
25.	Oriel Square	(a)	Western side; from a point 18 metres north of the southern highway boundary of Merton Street, northwards for a distance of 5 metres.
		(b)	Western side; from a point 23 metres north of the southern highway boundary of Merton street, northwards for a distance of 13 metres and for a width of 4.8 metres from the kerb line, parking perpendicular to the kerb.
26.	Parks Road	Eastern side; from a point 46 metres north of the northern kerb line of Holywell Street, northwards for a distance of 10 metres.	
27.	Pembroke Square	Northern side; from a point 21 metres west of the western kerb line of St. Aldate's, westwards for a distance of 8 metres.	
28.	Pusey Street	(a)	Southern side; from a point 13 metres west of the western kerb line of St. Giles', westwards for a distance of 11 metres.
		(b)	Southern side; from a point 42 metres east of the eastern kerb line of St. John Street, eastwards for a distance of 8 metres.
29.	Queen's Lane	Western side; from a point 42 metres north of the northern kerb line of High Street, northwards for a distance of 11 metres.	
30.	St. Aldate's	Eastern side; 13 metres south of a point opposite the southern kerb line of Pembroke Square, southwards for a distance of 20 metres.	
31.	St. Ebbe's Street	Eastern side; from a point 9 metres south of the southern kerb line of Pembroke Street, southwards for a distance of 20 metres.	
32.	St. Giles'	(a)	Western side; from a point 10.4 metres north of the northern boundary of No 65 St. Giles' and 3.6 metres east of the western kerb line of St Giles', to a point 12.4 metres approximately northwards and 4.5 metres east of the western kerb line of St Giles', parking at right-angles to the main carriageway of St Giles', for a distance of 5 metres eastwards.

		(b)	Western side; from a point 9.4 metres north of the northern kerb line of Pusey Street and 8.7 metres east of the western kerb line of St Giles', to a point 7.6 metres approximately northwards and 7.9 metres east of the western kerb line of St Giles', parking at right-angles to the main carriageway of St Giles', for a distance of 4.6 metres eastwards.
		(c)	Western side; from a point 21.3 metres south of the northern boundary of No 31 St. Giles', southwards for a distance of 11 metres, parking at right-angles to the kerb for a distance of 4.6 metres eastwards.
		(d)	Eastern side; from a point 4.7 metres north of the northern boundary of No 15 St. Giles' and 4.1 metres west of the eastern kerb line of St Giles', to a point 7.4 metres approximately northwards and 2.5 metres west of the eastern kerb line of St Giles', parking at right-angles to the main carriageway of St Giles', for a distance of 4.6 metres westwards.
		(e)	Northern kerb line of St. John's Terrace; from a point 7.7 metres west of the eastern kerb line of St Giles' northwards for a distance of 7.6 metres, parking at right-angles to the main carriageway of St Giles' for a distance of 4.6 metres westwards.
33.	St. John Street	(a)	Western side; from a point 73 metres north of the northern kerb line of Beaumont Street, northwards for a distance of 6.6 metres, outside No 58 St. John Street.
		(b)	Western side; from a point 112 metres north of the northern kerb line of Beaumont Street, northwards for a distance of 6.6 metres, outside No 51 St. John Street.
34.	St. Michael's Street	(a)	Northern side; from a point 25 metres east of the western flank wall of No.36 St Michael's Street eastwards for a distance of 13 metres.
		(b)	Northern side; from a point 54 metres east of the western flank wall of No.36 St Michael's Street eastwards for a distance of 25 metres.

35.	St Thomas' Street	North side; from the eastern end of the arched access to the rear of St Peter's College annexe, eastwards for a distance of 6.6 metres. Outside St Peter's College annex.	
36.	Walton Street	(a)	East side; from a point 31 metres south-west of the south-western kerb line of Little Clarendon Street, southwards for a distance of 6.6 metres.
		(b)	North-eastern side; from a point 60 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerblane of Observatory Street, south-eastwards for a distance of 30 metres.
37.	Wellington Square	Southern side; from a point 27 metres west of the eastern kerb line, westwards for a distance of 10 metres, outside Rewley House.	
38.	Wellington Street	(a)	North-west side; from a point 8 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb line of Albert Street, north-eastwards for a distance of 6 metres. Outside 48 Wellington Street.
		(b)	South-east side; from a point 66 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb line of Nelson Street, north-eastwards for a distance of 6 metres. Opposite No 45 Wellington Street.
39.	Worcester Place	North side; from a point 17 metres west of the western kerb line of Walton Street, westwards for a distance of 18 metres.
