



#### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

# OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PARK & RIDE PARKING PLACES – THORNHILL AND WATER EATON) VARIATION No. 1 ORDER 2013

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and Part IV of schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers and after consulting with Cherwell District and South Oxfordshire District Council in accordance with Section 39(1) of the Act and the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on 11 October 2013 and may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Park & Ride Parking Places – Thornhill and Water Eaton) Variation No. 1 Order 2013.
- (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment
  - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa
  - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment
  - (4) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall unless the context otherwise requires be construed as a reference to the numbered Article or Schedule bearing that number in the Park & Ride Order.

#### Variations

The Oxfordshire County Council (Park & Ride Parking Places – Thornhill and Water Eaton) Order 2012 ("the Park and Ride Order") is amended as follows and all references in such amendments to Articles

or Schedules are reference to Articles or Schedules in the Park and Ride Order (as so amended where the context so requires):-

3 (1) In Article 2 the definition of 'Charges' is deleted and replaced by the following:

"Charges" means the charges set out in Column 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order and where the context so requires signifies such charges discounted in accordance with any season ticket or similar arrangement as referred to in Article 29(3).

3 (2) Article 29 is deleted and replaced by the following:

#### "29 Charges

- (1) Save as provided in Articles 29(2) and 42(exemptions), no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in a Parking Place unless prior to the commencement of the relevant Parking Period specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 the Charge (if any) set out opposite in Column 2 of Schedule 2, or if applicable discounted charge as referred to in Article 29(3), has been paid to the Council.
- (2) The Charges set out in Schedule 2 are not payable when a Disabled Person's Vehicle, a Motor Cycle or a Cycle is parked in a Parking Place.
- (3) The Council may at its discretion introduce season tickets or other similar arrangements which may provide for any or all of the Charges to be discounted, and prior notification of any such arrangements shall be given in accordance with Regulation 25 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 as amended as well as being published on the Council's website".
- 3. (3) Article 31is deleted and replaced by the following:
  - "(1) Subject as provided in Article 31(2) an initial or subsequent (top up) payment of the Charge(s) may be undertaken by use of telephone, internet or a machine located in the Parking Place or by any other means designated by the Council from time to time, and all such payments shall be made in the manner and according to the instructions prescribed by the Council from time to time and which are displayed by notice in the Parking Place

- (2) Payment for any season ticket or similar arrangement as referred to in Article 29(3) shall be made in the manner and according to the instructions prescribed by the Council from time to time and which are published by the Council on its website
- (3) The appropriate Charge for the relevant Parking Period shall be made in accordance with Article 31(1) or applicable 31(2) prior to the commencement of that Parking Period"

## 3. (4) Schedule 2 is deleted and replaced by the following:

### "Schedule 2 Charges

	Parking Periods	Charges
1.	Not exceeding 1 hour	Nil
2.	Not exceeding 11 hours	£2.00
3.	Not exceeding 24 hours	£4.00
4.	Not exceeding 48 hours	£8.00
5.	Not exceeding 72 hours	£12.00

Note: - see Article 29(3) which gives discretion to the Council to arrange for season tickets or similar arrangements at discounted rates".
