The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), 2(2), 4(2), 32, 35 & 45 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act make the following Order:

 - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa
 - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment
