THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (MARSTON SOUTH) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (VARIATION No.12) ORDER 2014

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order

This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Marston South) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) (Variation No.12) Order 2014 and shall come into operation on the 21st day of December 2014.

- Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment
 - (2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment
 - (3) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.
 - (4) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article shall unless the context otherwise requires be construed as a reference to the numbered Article bearing that number in this Order.

- 1 Ferry Road
- a) South side:
- (i) From a point 33 metres west of the western kerb line of its junction with Marston Road, westwards for a distance of 21.5 metres.
- (ii) From a point 3.5 metres east of the common boundary of numbers 7 and 9 Ferry Road, westwards for a distance of 46m.
- (iii) From a point 3 metres east of the common boundary of numbers 21 and 23 Ferry Road, westwards for a distance of 30 metres.
- (iv) From a point in line with the common boundary of numbers 41 and 43 Ferry Road, westwards for a distance of 240.5 metres.
- b) North side:
- (i) From a point 49 metres west of the western kerb line of its junction with Marston Road, westwards for a distance of 83 metres.
- (ii) From a point 2 metres south east of the common boundary of numbers 34 and 38a Ferry Road, westwards for a distance of 29.5 metres.
- (iii) From a point 2.5 metres west of the common boundary of numbers 50 and 52 Ferry Road, westwards for a distance of 76 metres.
- (iv) From a point 3.5 m east the common boundary of numbers 74 and 76 Ferry Road, westwards for a distance of 87.5 metres
- (v) From a point 5 metres west of the common boundary of numbers 102 and 104 Ferry Road, westwards for a distance of 52 metres.

2 Hayes Close

North side: From the common boundary of numbers 15 and 16 Hayes Close westwards for a distance of 5 metres

- 3 William Street
- a) South side:
- (i) From a point 30m metres east of the eastern kerb line of its junction with Marston Road, eastwards for a distance of 47 metres.
- (ii) From the common property boundary of Nos.16 and 16a William Street, eastwards for a distance of 100 metres.
- (iii) From a point 5 metres west of the common property boundary of Nos. 44 and 46 William Street, eastwards for a distance of 78 metres.
- b) North side:
- (i) From a point 4 metres east of the common property boundary of Nos.65 and 67 William Street, westwards to a point 2.5 metres east of the common property boundary of Nos.59 and 61 William Street, an approximate distance of 18.5 metres.
- (ii) From a point in line with the common property boundary of Nos.47 and 49 William Street westwards for a distance of 50.5 metres.
- (iii) From a point 4.5 metres east of the common property boundary of Nos.31 and 31a William Street westwards for a distance of 4.5 metres.
- (iv) From a point 13.5 metres east of the common property boundary of Nos.25 and 27 William Street westwards, to a point 4 metres east of the common property boundary of Nos.13 and 15 William Street, an approximate distance of 45 metres.
- (v) From a point 3 metres west of the common property boundary of Nos.13 and 15 William Street westwards for a distance of 13 metres.
- (vi) North side: From a point 3 metres east of the common property boundary of Nos.7 and 9 William Street westwards for a distance of 33 metres.

There are excluded from the above lengths of road any Disabled Persons' Parking Places, Car Club Parking Places and any Controlled Length."
