The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45 and 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Headington West) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation No.16) Order 2015 and shall come into force on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of May 2015.
2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment
- (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa
- (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment
- (4) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall unless the context otherwise requires be construed as a reference to the numbered Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

The City of Oxford (Headington West) (Controlled Parking Zone) Order 2000 as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (Headington West) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation No.1) Order 2007, the Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places - Oxford) Order 2007, the Oxfordshire County Council (Headington West) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation No.2) Order 2008, the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford and North Hinksey) (Traffic Management Act 2004 – Consequential Provisions) Order 2008, the Oxfordshire County Council (Headington West) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation No.4) Order 2008, the Oxfordshire County Council (Headington West) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation No.5) Order 2008, the Oxfordshire County Council (Headington West) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation No.6) Order 2009, the Oxfordshire County Council (Headington West) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation No.9) Order 2010, and the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford) (Variation of Charges for Residents Permits) Order 2010, the Oxfordshire County Council (Headington West) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation No.10) Order 2011, the Oxfordshire County Council (Headington West) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation No.11) Order 2011, the Oxfordshire County Council (Headington West) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation No.13) Order 2012, the Oxfordshire County Council (Headington West) (Controlled Parking Zone) (Variation No.14) Order 2012, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Headington West) (Controlled Parking Zone)

(Variation No.15) Order 2013 ("the 2000 Order") is amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.

(c) South-western side, from a point 7 metres north-west of the north-western boundary of house number 15 north-westwards for a distance of 24 metres.

(d) Western side, from a point 2 metres north of the northern boundary of house number 6 northwards for a distance of 10 metres.

(e) Western side, from a point 7 metres south of the southern boundary of house number 7 southwards for a distance of 25 metres.

(c) Eastern side, from a point 43 metres north of the northern kerb line of Roosevelt Drive northwards for a distance of 11 metres.

(d) Northern side, from a point 12 metres east of opposite the eastern boundary of house number 80 eastwards for a distance of 10 metres.

(e) Northern side, from a point 15 metres east of the eastern boundary of house number 14 eastwards for a distance of 6 metres.

(f) Northern side, from a point 18 metres east of opposite the eastern boundary of house number 60 eastwards for a distance of 12 metres.

(g) South-western side, from a point 31 metres north-west of the north-western boundary of house number 15 north-westwards for a distance of 35 metres.

(h) Southern side, from a point 2 metres west of the eastern boundary of house number 74 eastwards for a distance of 6 metres.

(i) Southern side, from a point 4 metres east of the eastern boundary of house number 78 eastwards for a distance of 8 metres.

(j) Southern side, from a point 5 metres west of the western boundary of house number 7 westwards for a distance of 6 metres.

(k) Southern side, from a point 8 metres east of the eastern boundary of house number 74 eastwards for a distance of 6 metres.

(l) Western side, from a point 1 metre north of the southern boundary of house number 82 northwards for a distance of 6 metres.

(m) Western side, from a point 6 metres south of the southern boundary of house number 90 southwards for a distance of 10 metres.

(n) Western side, from a point 6 metres north of the southern boundary of house number 86 northwards for a distance of 11 metres.

4. Mileway  
Gardens

(a) Southern side, from a point 1 metre west of the western boundary of house number 15 westwards for a distance of 12 metres.

(b) Southern side, from a point 1 metres east of the eastern boundary of house number 2 eastwards for a distance of 6 metres.

(c) Southern side, from a point 10 metres west of the eastern boundary of house number 2 westwards for a distance of 6 metres.

(d) Western side, from a point 6 metres north of the northern boundary of house number 10 northwards for a distance of 11 metres.

(e) Western side, from a point 6 metres north of the northern boundary of house number 12 northwards for a distance of 7 metres.

(f) Western side, from a point 6 metres north of the northern boundary of house number 8 northwards for a distance of 6 metres.

(g) Western side, from a point 8 metres south of the southern boundary of house number 15 southwards for a distance of 15 metres.

(h) Eastern side, from a point opposite the southern boundary of house number 12 northwards for a distance of 6 metres.

5. Skene Close

(a) Eastern side, from a point 4 metres north of the northern boundary of house number 26 northwards for a distance of 6 metres.

(b) Northern side, from a point 5 metres west of the western boundary of house number 11 westwards for a distance of 6 metres."
