


**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(WALTON MANOR, OXFORD) (PARKING PLACES AND TRAFFIC
MANAGEMENT) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION No.15) ORDER 2016**

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) & (2), 4(2), 32, 35, 45 and 46 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Walton Manor, Oxford) (Parking Places and Traffic Management) (Consolidation) (Variation No.15) Order 2016 and shall come into operation on the 14th day of March 2016.
2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment
(2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa
(3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment

| 1. Canterbury Road | (a) Northern side; from a point 88 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Woodstock Road, eastwards for a distance of 53 metres. |
| | (b) Northern side; from a point 15 metres west of the western kerb line of Banbury Road, westwards for a distance of 41 metres. |
| | (c) Southern side; from a point 16 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Woodstock Road, eastwards for a distance of 26 metres. |
| 2. Kingston Road | Western side; from a point 18 metres north of the northern kerb line of Walton Well Road, northwards for a distance of 31 metres. |

3. Leckford Road
Northern side; from a point 15 metres west of the western kerb line of Woodstock Road, westwards for a distance of 58 metres.
4. Polstead Road
Southern side; from a point 110 metres west of the western kerb line of Woodstock Road, westwards for a distance of 10 metres.
5. St. Margarets Road
 - (a) Northern side; from a point 56 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Woodstock road, eastwards for a distance of 21 metres.
 - (b) Northern side; from a point 83 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Woodstock Road, eastwards for a distance of 8 metres.
 - (c) Northern side; from a point 95 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Woodstock Road, eastwards for a distance of 7 metres.
 - (d) Northern side; from a point 106 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Woodstock Road, eastwards for a distance of 10 metres.
 - (e) Northern side; from a point 121 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Woodstock Road, eastwards for a distance of 11 metres.

- (f) Northern side; from a point 137 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Woodstock Road, eastwards for a distance of 14 metres.
- (g) Northern side; from a point 156 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Woodstock Road, eastwards for a distance of 13 metres.
- (h) Northern side; from a point 174 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Woodstock Road, eastwards for a distance of 6 metres.
- (i) Northern side; from a point 185 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Woodstock Road, eastwards for a distance of 16 metres.
- (j) Southern side; from a point 57 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Woodstock Road, eastwards for a distance of 53 metres.
- (k) Southern side; from a point 57 metres west of the western kerb line of Banbury Road, westwards for a distance of 60 metres.
- (l) Southern side; from a point 215 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Woodstock Road, eastwards for a distance of 29 metres.

6. Tackley Place

Southern side; from a point 13 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Kingston Road, eastwards for a distance of 20 metres.”
