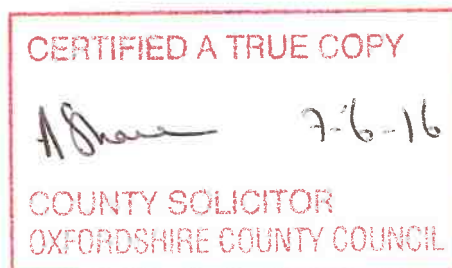


**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CITY OF OXFORD) (MODIFICATION OF RENEWAL MECHANISM FOR
RESIDENTS PERMITS AND VISITORS PERMITS) ORDER 2016**

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 45 and 46 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford) (Modification of Renewal Mechanism for Residents Permits and Visitors Permits) Order 2016 and shall come into force on the thirteenth day of June 2016.
2. In this Order
"Orders" means the orders listed in column 1 of the Schedule.
"Schedule" means the Schedule to this Order
3.
 - (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment
 - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa
 - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment



4. **Definitions**

The definitions in each of the Orders are varied as follows:

- 4.1 Where there is no definition of “Renewal Date” the following is inserted and where there is a definition of “Renewal Date” it is revoked and replaced by the following:

“Renewal Date” means for each Resident of the age of 17 years or more the date subsequent to the Modification Order coming into force on which that Resident is first issued with an allocation (25 days’ worth) of Visitors’ Permits free of charge applying the transitional provisions incorporated in this Order by the Modification Order and each anniversary of that date (so that for the avoidance of doubt each Resident of the age of 17 years or more will thereby have a personal Renewal Date)”

- 4.2 Where there is a definition of “Year” or “year” in an Order it is revoked and replaced by the following:

“Year”/“year” means for each Resident of the age of 17 years or more the year commencing on the Renewal Date for that Resident”

- 4.3 There is inserted in each Order the following definition:

“Modification Order” means the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford) (Modification of Renewal Mechanism for Resident’ Permits and Visitors’ Permits) Order 201*”

5. **Variation to Residents’ Permit Terms**

Each of the Orders listed in Part 1 of the Schedule is varied by the revocation of the article of the relevant Order as specified in column 2 of Part 1 of the Schedule and its replacement by the following:

“The Council will fix the day when a Residents’ Permit issued to a Resident will cease to be valid”.

6. Variation to Visitors' Permit Terms

6.1 Each of the relevant Orders listed in Part 2 of the Schedule is varied by the revocation of the article of the relevant Order as specified in column 3 of Part 2 of the Schedule

6.2 Each of the relevant Orders listed in Part 1 of the Schedule is varied by the insertion in the article of the relevant Order as specified in column 4 of the Schedule after the words "the Renewal Date" of the following:

"for that Resident"

6.3 Each of the relevant Orders is varied by the deletion from the article of the relevant Order as specified in column 5 of the Schedule of all the words in parentheses starting "(commencing on)" and its replacement by the following:

"(commencing on the Renewal Date for that Resident)"

7. Transitional Provisions (1)

There is inserted in each of the Orders (excepting those specified in Part 2 of the Schedule at items 9, 10, 11 and 12) after the relevant article specified in column 6 of the Schedule the following article (A):

- "(1) Subject always as provided below in this article a Resident of the age of 17 years or more (other than a Resident (Short-term)) will be entitled to his first allocation of 25 days' worth of Visitors' Permits free of charge on the date subsequent to the Modification Order coming into force when that Resident requests such allocation.
- (2) Where during the year commencing on the date relating to this Order as specified in column 7 of the Schedule to the Modification Order (but prior to the date on which the Modification Order comes into force) a Resident has received an allocation of 25 days' worth of Visitors' Permits free of charge but no further allocation of Visitors' Permits that Resident:
- (a) shall be entitled to a second allocation of 25 days' worth of Visitors' Permits at a charge of £20 (provided always that the price reduction for any Resident aged 70 years or older shall continue to apply)
- (b) shall not be entitled to an allocation of 25 days' worth of Visitors' Permits free of charge until the date relating to this Order as specified in column 8 of the Schedule to the Modification Order (provided always that this does not affect the issue of additional Visitors' Permits at the Councils discretion)
- (3) Where during the year commencing on the date relating to this Order as specified in column 7 of the Schedule to the Modification Order (but prior to the date on which the Modification Order comes into force) a Resident has received his full allocation of 50 Visitors' Permits that Resident:

- (a) shall not be entitled to any further allocation of Visitors' Permits until the date relating to this Order as specified in column 8 of the Schedule to the Modification Order (provided always that this does not affect the issue of additional Visitors' Permits at the Councils discretion)
 - (b) shall be entitled to an allocation of 25 days' worth of Visitors' Permits free of charge from the date relating to this Order as specified in column 8 of the Schedule to the Modification Order.
- (4) The provisions of this Order as to the allocation of Visitors' Permits to a Resident (Short-Term) shall continue to apply."

Transitional Provisions (2)

8. There is inserted in each of the Orders specified in Part 2 of the Schedule to the Modification Order at items 9,10,11 and 12 the following article 25A:

"25A (1) Subject always as provided in articles 25A (2) and (3) a Resident of the age of 17 years or more will be entitled to his first allocation of 25 days' worth of Visitors' Permits free of charge on the date subsequent to the Modification Order coming into force when that Resident first requests such allocation (and that date shall be his Renewal Date)

25A (2) Where during the year commencing on the date relating to this Order as specified in column 7 of the Schedule to the Modification Order but prior to the date the Modification Order comes into force a Resident has received an allocation of 25 days' worth of Visitors' Permits but no further allocation that Resident shall be entitled to a further allocation of 25 days' worth of Visitors' Permits free of charge on request

25A (3) Where during the year commencing on the date relating to this Order as specified in column 7 of the Modification Order but prior to the date the Modification Order comes into force a Resident has received his full allocation of 50 days' worth of Visitors' Permits that Resident shall not be entitled to a further allocation until the date relating to this Order as specified in column 8 of the Modification Order (provided always that this does affect the issue of additional Visitors' Permits at the Councils discretion)

25A (4) The provisions of this Order as to the allocation of Visitors' Permits to a Resident (Short-Term) shall continue to apply".
