OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CENTRAL AREA, OXFORD) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (VARIATION NO.13) ORDER 2017

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35, 45 and 46 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Central Area) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) (Variation No.13) Order 2017 and shall come into operation on the 23rd day of October 2017.
- 2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
 - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.
 - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.

 - (a) for a period longer than 20 minutes; or
 - (b) if a period of less than two hours has elapsed since the termination during the Prescribed Hours of the last period of parking of the vehicle in the same Parking Place.
 - (2) in any Timed Parking Place specified in Part A of Schedule 4 to this Order:
 - (a) for a period longer than 30 minutes; or
 - (b) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination during the Prescribed Hours of the last period of parking of the vehicle in the same Parking Place.
 - (3) in any Timed Parking Place specified in Part B subject to Part C of Schedule 4 to this Order:
 - (a) for a period longer than one hour; or
 - (b) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination during the Prescribed Hours of the last period of parking of the vehicle in the same Parking Place.
 - (4) in any Timed Parking Place specified in Part D of Schedule 4 to this Order;
 - (a) for a period longer than two hours; or
 - (b) if a period of less than two hours has elapsed since the termination during the Prescribed Hours of the last period of parking of the vehicle in the same Parking Place."

PART XII VEHICLE LOADING BAYS

"Designation of Vehicle Loading Bay

- 57. (1) Each of the lengths of road specified in Parts A, B and F of Schedule 8 to this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the provisions of this Order during the Prescribed Hours as a Parking Place for any Goods Vehicle for the purpose of being loaded or unloaded in connection with any trade or business [situated in a road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order)
 - (2) Each of the lengths of road specified in Parts C, D, E, G and H of Schedule 8 to this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, during the Prescribed Hours as a Parking Place for any vehicle for the purpose of being loaded or unloaded in connection with any trade or business situated in a road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

Restriction on Waiting- Loading Bay only

- 58. Save as provided in Article 12(3)-(10) (exemptions modified) no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer, the Council or a police constable in uniform, cause or permit,
 - (1) a vehicle to wait during the Prescribed Hours in any vehicle Loading Bay specified in Parts A, B and F of Schedule 8 unless it is a Goods Vehicle waiting for the purpose of being loaded or unloaded in connection with any trade or business situated in the road specified to Schedule 1 to this Order:
 - (2) a vehicle to wait during the Prescribed Hours in any Vehicle Loading Bay specified in Parts C, D, E and G of Schedule 8 to this Order unless it is waiting for the purpose of being loaded or unloaded in connection with any trade or business situated in a road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
 - (3) a vehicle to wait during the Prescribed Hours in the Vehicle Loading Bay specified in Part H of Schedule 8 to this Order unless it is waiting for the purpose of being loaded or unloaded in connection with any trade or business situated in that road, or being loaded or unloaded by a resident of or visitor to Mill Stream House.

Restriction on Waiting – Position

59 (1) Save as is provided in article 59 (2), unless the exemptions as specified in Article 12(3) – (10) applies (exemption modified) no person is to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a Vehicle Loading Bay unless it is parked with every part of the vehicle on the carriage way and entirely within the limits of the Vehicle Loading Bay as marked provided always that if the Vehicle

Loading Bay is sub-divided it must also be parked entirely within the limits of one of the sub-divided spaces as marked.

(2) Nothing in article 59 (1) shall apply to lengths of road specified in Schedule 8 Part C and Part H where a vehicle is parked wholly or partially (as appropriate) on the footway and entirely within the limits of the Vehicle Loading Bay as marked, provided always that if the Vehicle Loading Bay is sub-divided it must also be parked entirely within the limits of one of the sub-divided spaces as marked.

Time Limits on Waiting

- 60. Save as provided in Article 12(3) (10) (exemptions modified) no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer or a police constable in uniform, cause or permit a vehicle to wait during the Prescribed Hours;
 - (1) in any Vehicle Loading Bay specified in Parts A, B and D of Schedule 8 to this Order:
 - (a) for a period longer than one hour, or
 - (b) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination during the Prescribed Hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in the same Vehicle Loading Bay.
 - (2) in any Vehicle Loading Bay specified in Parts C, E and F of Schedule 8 to this Order:
 - (a) for a period longer than 30 minutes, or
 - (b) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination during the Prescribed Hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of that vehicle in the same Vehicle Loading Bay.
 - (3) in any Vehicle Loading Bay specified in Part H of Schedule 8 to this Order:
 - (a) for a period longer than 20 minutes, or
 - (b) if a period of less than two hours has elapsed since the termination during the Prescribed Hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of that vehicle in the same Vehicle Loading Bay.

General.

61. The provisions of Part IV of the Order will apply to any Vehicle Loading Bay."

INSERT new PART XVII to the Order:

"PART XVII CLEARWAY

68. Prohibition of waiting and Loading

Save as provided in Article 69 of this Order, no person is to cause or permit any vehicle to wait, or wait for the purposes of loading and unloading in any Clearway Road specified in Schedule 12 to this Order, during Clearway Hours every day, except upon the direction or with the permission of the Council, a Civil Enforcement Officer or a police constable in uniform.

69. Exemptions from Clearway Restriction

Nothing in Article 68 of this Order will apply to any vehicle waiting in any road specified in Schedule 12 to this Order for so long only as may be necessary if:

- (1) the vehicle is being used for police purposes, is an ambulance, or is in the service of the fire brigade being used for fire brigade purposes;
- (2) the vehicle is a Bus being used in the provision of a Local Service waiting at any bus stop in order to set down or pick up passengers;
- (3) the vehicle is in the service of or employed by a Universal Service Provider or being used for the purpose of loading, unloading, delivering or collecting Postal Packets at premises or post boxes at or adjoining that road;
- (4) the vehicle is waiting in any designated Vehicle Loading Bay, detailed in Schedule 8 to this Order, for the purposes of loading or unloading;
- (5) the vehicle is waiting because the person in control of the vehicle is required by law to stop, or is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident or is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control;
- (6) the vehicle is being used in connection with any of the following and cannot conveniently be so used without waiting in that road:
 - (a) removing any obstruction to traffic in or adjoining that road;
 - (b) undertaking urgent works in relation to that road or to a traffic sign, road lighting or street furniture at or adjoining that road;
 - (c) undertaking urgent works in relation to a sewer or water main or in relation to the supply of gas, electricity, water or communication services in or adjoining that road;
 - (d) a funeral associated with premises at or adjoining that road and is a hearse or other official vehicle of an undertaker.

provided that the person in control of the vehicle must move it on the instruction of a police constable in uniform, wherever that police constable considers this necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction."
