OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (OXFORD CITY) (DESIGNATION AND REGULATION OF PAY AND DISPLAY PARKING PLACES) (VARIATION, NO.2) ORDER 2019

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35, 45 and 46 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford City) (Designation and Regulation of Pay and Display Parking Places) (Variation No.2) Order 2019 and shall come into force on the 8th day of April 2019.
- 2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
 - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.
 - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
- 3. The Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford City) (Designation and Regulation of Pay and Display Parking Places) Order 2017, as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford City) (Designation and Regulation of Pay and Display Parking Places) (Variation No.1) Order 2018 ("the 2017 Order") is amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this order.

Amendments to "the 2017 Order":

The below definition is deleted and replaced as follows:

"Charging Hours" means: in relation to any Parking Place specified in Schedule 1 to this order, from 8.00am to 10.00pm on every day"

2.)

Article 14 is deleted and replaced as follows:

Exemptions – Residents Permits (Norham Manor)

- "Nothing in Article 12 (Restriction on return) or 13 (Parking Ticket required) shall apply to a Permitted Vehicle waiting in a Parking Place specified in Part 3 of Schedule 1 if there is displayed in the Relevant Position on the vehicle at all times during which the vehicle is left in that Parking Place during the Charging Hours, a valid permit issued to a resident (as defined in The City of Oxford (Norham Manor) (Controlled Parking Zone) Order 1999 as amended) under the provisions of Article 21 of that order in respect of that vehicle."
- Schedules 1 and 2 are deleted and replaced with the following:

6. KING EDWARD STREET

West side; from a point 5 metres north of the centre kerb line of Bear Lane, northwards for a distance of 46 metres.

7. LONGWALL STREET

East side; from a point 122 metres north of the northern kerb line of High Street, northwards for a distance of 77 metres.

8. MANSFIELD ROAD

- (a) West side; from a point 13 metres north of the northern kerb line of Saville Road northwards for a distance of 23 metres
- (b) West side; from a point 41 metres north of the northern kerb line of Saville Road northwards for a distance of 28 metres
- (c) West side; from a point 82 metres north of the northern kerb line of Saville Road northwards for a distance of 6 metres
- (d) West side; from a point 95 metres north of the northern kerb line of Saville Road northwards for a distance of 25 metres
- (e) West side; from a point 140 metres north of the northern kerb line of Saville Road northwards for a distance of 45 metres
- (f) East side; from a point 2 metres north of the southern flank wall of number 5A Mansfield Road northwards for a distance of 11 metres
- (g) East side; from a point 18 metres north of the southern flank wall of number 5A Mansfield Road northwards for a distance of 24 metres
- (h) East side; from a point 53 metres north of the southern flank wall of number 5A Mansfield Road northwards for a distance of 20 metres
- (i) East side; from a point 79 metres north of the southern flank wall of number 5A Mansfield Road northwards for a distance of 22 metres
- (j) East side; from a point 113 metres north of the southern flank wall of number 5A Mansfield Road northwards for a distance of 14 metres
- (k) East side; from a point 134 metres north of the southern flank wall of number 5A Mansfield Road northwards for a distance of 30 metres
- (I) East side; from a point 176 metres north of the southern flank wall of number 5A Mansfield Road northwards for a distance of 82 metres

9. MERTON STREET

South side; from a point 145 metres east of the centre line of Magpie Lane, eastwards for a distance of 40 metres.

(a) East side; from a point 56 metres north of the northern kerb line of Holywell Street, northwards for a distance of 23 metres.

(b) North side; from a point 43 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Parks Road, westwards for a distance of 27 metres.

11. PARKS ROAD

- (a) East side; from a point 56 metres north of the northern kerb line of Holywell Street, northwards for a distance of 23 metres.
- (b) East side; from a point 94 metres north of the northern kerb line of Holywell Street, northwards for a distance of 26 metres.
- (c) East side; from a point 125 metres north of the northern kerb line of Holywell Street, northwards for a distance of 30 metres.

12. SAVILE ROAD

- (a) North side; from a point 12 metres west of the western kerb line of Mansfield Road westwards for a distance of 35 metres
- (b) North side; from a point 52 metres west of the western kerb line of Mansfield Road westwards for a distance of 19 metres
- (c) South side; from a point 13 metres west of the western kerb line of Mansfield Road westwards for a distance of 17 metres
- (d) South side; from a point 39 metres west of the western kerb line of Mansfield Road westwards for a distance of 19 metres

13. ST. GILES

- (a) West side; from a point opposite a point 17.8 metres north of the northern kerb line of Pusey Street, northwards for a distance of 24.6 metres and for an average width of 5.8 metres westwards from the line of trees.
- (b) West side; from a point opposite a point 50 metres north of the northern kerb line of Pusey Street, northwards for a distance of 111 metres, and for an average width of 5 metres westwards from the line of trees.
- (c) West side; from a point 167 metres north of the northern kerb line of Pusey Street, northwards for a distance 27 metres and for an average width of 4.5 metres from the edge of the carriageway.
- (d) West side; from a point opposite a point 9 metres south of the southern kerb line of Pusey Street, southwards for a distance of 39 metres, and for an average width of 7 metres westwards from the line of trees.

- (e) West side; from a point opposite a point 48 metres south of the kerb line of Pusey Street, southwards for a distance of 13 metres, and for an average width of 4.9 metres westwards from the line of trees.
- (f) East side; from a point 8.4 metres north of the northern kerb line of St John's Terrace, northwards for a distance of 125.6 metres, and an average width of 6.8 metres eastwards from the line of trees.
- (g) East side; from a point 164.4 metres north of the northern kerb line of St John's Terrace, northwards for a distance of 45.6 metres, and for an average width of 5 metres eastwards from the line of trees.

14. WELLINGTON SQUARE

- (a) North side; from the western kerb line, eastwards for a distance of 41 metres.
- (b) West side; from the southern kerb line, northwards for a distance of 12 metres and for a width of 5 metres from the edge of the carriageway
- (c) West side; from a point 12 metres north of the southern kerb line, northwards for a distance of 41 metres and for a width of 2 metres from the edge of the carriageway
- (d) West side; from a point 53 metres north of the southern kerb line, northwards to a point 2 metres south of the northern kerb line and for a width of 5 metres from the edge of the carriageway.

15. WOODSTOCK ROAD

- (a) West side; from a point 15 metres south of the southern kerb line of Observatory Street, southwards for a distance of 72 metres.
- (b) Western side; from a point 93 metres south of the southern kerb line of Observatory Street, southwards for a distance of 14 metres.
- (c) Western side; from a point 128 metres south of the southern kerb line of Observatory Street, southwards for a distance of 5 metres.

- (g) South side; from a point 8 metres east of the point opposite the eastern kerb line of Fyfield Road, eastwards for a distance of 16 metres.

4. WALTON STREET

- (a) Southwest side; from a point 98 metres northwest of the northwestern kerb line of Walton Crescent; north-westwards for a distance of 27 metres.
- (b) Northeast side; from a point 117 metres southeast of the southeastern kerb line of Observatory Street, south-eastwards for a distance of 18 metres.

- (c) Northeast side; from a point 149 metres south-east of the south-eastern kerb line of Observatory Street, south-eastwards for a distance of 15 metres.
- (d) Northeast side; from a point 170 metres southeast of the southeastern kerb line of Observatory Street, south-eastwards for a distance of 20 metres.
- (e) Northeast side; from a point 220 metres southeast of the southeastern kerb line of Observatory Street, south-eastwards for a distance of 15 metres.

- (c) South side; from a point 24 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Banbury Road, eastwards for a distance of 42 metres.
- (d) South side; from a point 14 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Fyfield Road, eastwards to Benson Place.
