## OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CENTRAL AREA, OXFORD) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (VARIATION NO.15) ORDER 2019

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35, 45 and 46 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Central Area) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) (Variation No.15) Order 2019 0and shall come into force on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of July 2019.
- 2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment
  - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa
  - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment
