## OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (WANTAGE, MARKET PLACE AREA) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING AND WAITING) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2021

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 9 and 10 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as The Oxfordshire County Council (Wantage Market Place Area) (Prohibition of Driving and Waiting) Experimental Order 2021 and shall come into force on the third day of January 2021.
- 2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
  - (2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
- 3. The effect of this Experimental order is to temporarily suspend waiting provisions in the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads West Oxfordshire) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Permitted Parking) Order 2012 (as amended) as specified in the Schedule to this order.
- 4. Save as provided by article 5 of this order no person shall, when and where appropriate signage is in place, other than with the consent of the County Council, the District Council, a police constable in uniform, or Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit a vehicle to proceed or wait in the sections of road specified in the Schedule to this order.
- 5. Nothing in article 4 shall make it unlawful for a vehicle to proceed or wait in the sections of road specified in the Schedule to this order for any of the purposes stated in the exemptions to parking provisions within article 18 (items 1 to 8, and 10 & 11) of the Order specified in article 3 of this order.
- 6. If the provisions of this Experimental Order, or any of them are made permanent, the measures specified will be incorporated into the existing order specified in article 3 of this order.

- 7. The Director for Environment and Place / Communities of the County Council is empowered to modify or suspend this Order or any provision of it pursuant to and in accordance with Section 10(2) of the Act.
- 8. The Oxfordshire County Council (Wantage, Market Place Area) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles and Waiting) Order 2020 is hereby revoked.
- This Order shall continue in force for a period of 18 months from the date on which it comes into force.

- 2.) in the southern section of Alfred Street
  No Waiting 8am to 6pm Monday to Saturday
- 3.) in the northern section of Church Street.

## **Prohibition of Driving**

- 1.) the western section of Market Place to The Cloisters/Church Street
- 2.) the southern section of Alfred Street
- 3.) the northern section of Church Street.
