THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (OXFORD - CAR CLUB PARKING PLACES) (VARIATION No.5) ORDER 2022

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) & 2 (1) & (2), 4, 32, 35, 45 and 46, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 and of all other enabling powers make the following Order.

This order shall be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford - Car Club Parking Places) (Variation No.5) Order 2022 and shall come into force on the 31st day of January 2022.

- (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
- (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.
- (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
- 2. The Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Car Club Parking Places) Order 2010, as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Car Club Parking Places) (Variation No.1) Order 2012, the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Car Club Parking Places) (Variation No.2) Order 2013, the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Car Club Parking Places) (Variation No.3) Order 2016, and Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Car Club Parking Places) (Variation No.3) Order 2016, and Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Car Club Parking Places) (Variation No.4) Order 2018 ("the 2010 Order") is amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

Amendments to "the 2010 Order":

1.)

In article 2 - Definitions the following entries are replaced:

"Authorised Zone" means the relevant Zone in which a Zone Club Operator has been authorised by the Council to manage and administer the allocation and use of Car Club Permits for some or all of the Car Club Parking Places in that Zone or CPZ;

"Car Club Parking Place(s)" means any length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order (but excluding any Controlled Length), which is authorised to be used as a parking place for a vehicle, subject to the provisions of this Order.

and either:

- (1) with each Car Club Parking Place has a Car Club Parking Place Identifier, or
- (2) any place a car club vehicle is parked in a residents` permit parking place it displays in the relevant position a Car Club Permit and CPZ identifier:

"Parking Place Orders" means the Orders specified in Schedule 2 to this Order, as amended from time to time;

"vehicle" means a motor vehicle being a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads, and includes an electric vehicle or hybrid electric vehicle;

In article 2 – Definitions, the following is entered alphabetically:

"CPZ" means a Controlled Parking Zone which is a restricted parking area in the Oxford area;

The below articles are replaced as follows:

"Authorisation of Car Club Parking Places

4. Each of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as a parking place for any Permitted Vehicle belonging to or on hire or lease or otherwise associated with the relevant Zone Car Club Operator and which displays in the Relevant Position a valid Car Club Permit bearing the Car Club Parking Place Identifier or CPZ identifier, for that parking place and a valid Operator's Permit for that vehicle."

"Restrictions on Parking – Permit Requirements

- 6. Save as provided in Article 9 (exemption) no person is to cause or permit any vehicles to wait in any Car Club Parking Place during the Prescribed Hours, except upon the direction or permission of the Civil Enforcement Officer, the Council or a Police Constable in uniform, unless there is displayed in the Relevant Position on the vehicle at all times during which the vehicle is left in the Car Club Parking Place during the Prescribed Hours:-
 - (1) a valid Car Club Permit bearing the Car Club Parking Place Identifier for that Car Club Parking Place or CPZ identifier ; and
 - (2) a valid Operator's Permit in respect of that vehicle.

Restrictions on Use

- 7. The Driver of a vehicle using a parking place must stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and must not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
- 8. No person is to use any vehicle while it is in a parking place
 - in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near it or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services.
 - (2) for eating, cooking, sleeping or camping purposes;"

"CAR CLUB PERMIT SCHEME

13. A Zone Club Operator may apply to the Council for the issue of a Car Club Permit for the leaving, subject to provisions of this Order, during the Prescribed Hours in a Car Club Parking Place or CPZ in the relevant Authorised Zone of a Permitted Vehicle that:

(1) belongs to or is on hire or lease to or otherwiseassociated with that Zone Club Operator; and

(2) is on hire to or is left for the purposes of being hired to a current member of the Car Club operated by that Zone Club Operator."

"Application

15. (1) An application for a Car Club Permit must be made on a form issued by and obtained from the Council and include the particulars and information required by such form and must be accompanied by a remittance for the charge specified in Article 14(4)

(2) The Council may require an applicant for a Car Club Permit to

produce such evidence in respect of its application as the Council may reasonably require to verify any particulars or information given to the Council including the accreditation of the Car Club

(3) Subject as provided in Article 15 (4) if the charge specified in Article 14 (4) has been paid and the information and particulars required to be supplied by the application form have been supplied to the satisfaction of the Council and the

Council is satisfied as to the completed application form then, if the applicant has been authorised by the Council to manage and administer car club parking places identified in the application and such authorisation remains current, the Council will issue to the applicant a Car Club Permit for the leaving, subject to the provisions of this Order, of a Permitted Vehicle in a Car Club Parking Place or CPZ as identified in the application.

(4) The Council will not issue a Car Club Permit for a Car Club Parking Place if a Car Club Permit which remains valid has been issued for that Car Club Parking Place.

(5) The Council will not issue a Car Club Permit to an applicant if, during the period of 3 months prior to the application, any Car Club Permit issued to that applicant has been withdrawn by the Council further to Article 18 (5).

(6) The Council may at any time require a person who is using a Car Club Permit to produce to the Council such evidence as may reasonably be required to verify that the permit is valid and/or such person is eligible to use such permit."

"Permit Formalities

17. A Car Club Permit will include the following particulars:-

the period during which, subject to the provisions of Article 19 of this
Order, the Car Club Permit will remain valid;

(2) the Car Club Parking Place or CPZ Identifier of the parking place where a permit may be used;

(3) the name of the Zone Club Operator to whom the CarClub Parking Permit has been issued;

(4) an indication that the Car Club Permit has been issued by

the Council."
