OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (OXFORD, BROAD STREET AND OBSERVATORY STREET) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2022

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 9 and 10 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as The Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford, Broad Street and Observatory Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Experimental Order 2022 and shall come into force on the second day of February 2022.
- (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
 - (2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
- 3. The effect of this Experimental order is to temporarily suspend waiting provisions in the following traffic orders as specified in the Schedule to this order:
 - a) The Oxfordshire County Council (the Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places Oxford) Order 2010 (as amended) "the 2010 Order";
 - b) the Oxfordshire County Council (Central Area Oxford) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) Order 2011 (as amended) "the 2011 Order";
 - c) the Oxfordshire County Council (City of Oxford) (Jericho) (Parking Places and Controlled Parking Zone) Order 2000 (as amended) "the 2000 Order".
- 4. Save as provided by article 5 of this order no person shall, when appropriate signage is in place, other than with the consent of the County Council, the Oxford City Council, a police constable in uniform, or Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit a vehicle to wait in the sections of road specified in the Schedule to this order.
- 5. Nothing in article 4 shall make it unlawful for a vehicle to wait in the section road specified in the Schedule to this order, for any of the purposes stated in the exemptions to the prohibition of waiting within the orders specified in article 3 of this order.

- 6. The prohibitions imposed by Article 4 shall apply in relation to any part of the section of road to such extent and at such times as there are in place traffic signs (within the meaning of Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984) indicating that such prohibition is in operation at that part.
- 7. If the provisions of this Experimental Order, or any of them are made permanent, the measures specified will be incorporated by amendments into the existing orders specified in article 3 of this order, as appropriate.
- 8. The Director for Environment and Place / Communities of the County Council is empowered to modify or suspend this Order or any provision of it pursuant to and in accordance with Section 10(2) of the Act.
- 9. The Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford, Broad Street) (No.2) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2020 is hereby revoked.
- 10. This Order shall continue in force for a period of 18 months from the date on which it comes into force.

Suspension of Waiting

- "the 2010 Order" and "the 2011 Order" the section of Broad Street, north side outside Blackwells and The White Horse, Disabled Persons Parking Places and part of Loading Bay - from a point 69 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Turl Street, eastwards for 13.2 metres.
- 2.) "the 2000 Order" the section of Observatory Street, southeast side beside the Jericho Café, 2 parking bays (2-hour permitted parking 8am to 6.30pm Monday to Saturday, No return within 2 hours).
