

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(MARSTON SOUTH) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE AND WAITING  
RESTRICTIONS) (VARIATION No.24) ORDER 2022**

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Marston South) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) (Variation No.24) Order 2022 and shall come into operation on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of March 2022.

  - (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment
  - (2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment
  - (3) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.

- a) From a point 4.5 metres north of common boundary of numbers 414 and 416 Marston Road southwards for a distance of 9.5metres.
- b) From a point 5.5 metres north of common boundary of numbers 418 and 420 with Marston Road southwards for a distance of 10 metres.
- c) From a point 4.5 metres north of the common boundary of numbers 422 and 424 with Marston Road southwards for a distance of 9.5 metres.
- d) From a point 7.5 metres southwest of the southern kerb line

of its northerly kerb line with Crotch Crescent south westwards for a distance of 11 metres.

- 11 Old Marston Road South Side:
- a) From a point 4.5m west of the common boundary of numbers 19 and 21 Old Marston Road, westwards for a distance of 26.5 metres.


