OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (OXFORD AREA - VARIOUS STREETS) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PERMITTED PARKING) (VARIATION No.4) ORDER 2022

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) & (2), 4, 32 & 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Area -Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Permitted Parking) (Variation No.4) Order 2022 and shall come into force on the first day of April 2022.
- (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
 - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.
 - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Area Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Permitted Parking) Order 2022, as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Area Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Permitted Parking) (Variation No.1) Order 2022, the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Area Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Permitted Parking) (Variation No.2) Order 2022, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Area Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Permitted Parking) (Variation No.3) Order 2022 ("the 2022 Order") is amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.

In article 2 – Definitions, the following are added alphabetically:

"Coach" means a motor coach (not being a bus) being a single deck vehicle used to transport passengers for reward or otherwise,

"maximum gross weight" means:-

- (a) in the case of a motor vehicle not drawing a trailer or in the case of a trailer, its maximum laden weight;
- (b) in the case of an articulated vehicle, its maximum laden weight (if it has one) and otherwise the aggregate maximum laden weight of all the individual vehicles forming part of that articulated vehicle; and
- (c) in the case of a motor vehicle (other than an articulated vehicle) drawing one or more trailers, the aggregate maximum laden weight of the motor vehicle and the trailer or trailers drawn by it. "
- 4.)
 Articles 9 and 10 are replaced as follows:

PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS ON WAITING

"9 Restrictions on Waiting

Save as provided in Articles 10 and 11, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any Restricted Road during the Restricted Hours except upon the direction or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer or a police constable in uniform.

9A. Restrictions on Waiting - Coaches and HGVs

Save as provided in Articles 10 and 11, no person shall cause or permit:

- (1) any Coach, or
- (2) any Goods Vehicle with a Maximum Gross Weight exceeding 5 tonnes, to wait during the Restricted Hours in the length of road specified in Schedule 22 to this order, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer or a police constable in uniform.

10. Exemptions from Prohibition and Restrictions on Waiting

Nothing in Articles 9 or 9A. shall apply to any vehicle waiting in any Restricted Road during the Restricted Hours for so long only as may be necessary in any of the following circumstances, provided always to the extent that any Restricted Road is also a Loading and Unloading Ban Road or a Clearway then the following exemptions shall only apply during the Loading Ban Hours or as applicable the Clearway Hours, in so far as such exemptions are covered in Articles 6 or 8 as applicable,

- (1) where the vehicle is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (2) to enable a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
- (3) where the vehicle is in the service of a local authority operating under statutory powers or duties;
- (4) where the vehicle is used by a Universal Service Provider in the course of provision of a universal postal service for deliveries or collections;
- (5) where the vehicle is a Taxi or Licensed Private Hire Vehicle waiting at any authorised taxi rank or stand;
- (6) for the closing or opening of any gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle requires access or exit if it is not reasonably practicable for the vehicle to wait otherwise than in the Restricted Road when such gate or other barrier is being opened or closed;
- (7) where the vehicle is waiting when the person in control of the vehicle is obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident or is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control;
- (8) where the vehicle is being used in connection with any of the following and cannot conveniently be so used without being parked as mentioned in that road:
- (9) undertaking any building operation, demolition or excavation;
- (10) removing any obstruction to traffic;
- (11) undertaking works in relation to a road, a traffic sign or street lighting;
- (12) undertaking works in relation to a sewer or water main, or in relation to the supply of gas, electricity, water or communication services;
- (13) any funeral;
- (14) where the vehicle is being used for the purposes of delivering Goods to, or collecting Goods from any premises situated in or adjoining that road or is being loaded from or unloaded to any premises;
- (15) where a Public Service Vehicle is being used in the provision of the Local Service and is waiting at any bus stop in order to set down or pick up passengers, provided that the person in control of the vehicle must move it on the instruction of a police constable in uniform, wherever that police constable considers this necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction."
