## OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (OXFORD CENTRAL AREA - TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) (ST MICHAEL STREET) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2022

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 9 and 10 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Traffic Orders Procedure (Coronavirus) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2020 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as The Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford Central Area Traffic Management) (St Michael Street) Experimental Order 2020 and shall come into force on the second day of March 2022.
- (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
  - (2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
- 3. The effect of this order is to temporarily amend The Oxfordshire County Council (The City of Oxford) (Central Area) (Traffic Management) (Consolidation) Order 2003, as amended ("the 2003 Order").
- 4. PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES

The 2003 Order shall be temporarily amended as specified in the Schedule to this order.

- 5. If the provisions of this experimental Order, or any of them are made permanent, the measures specified will be added to the "the 2003 Order" as appropriate.
- 6. The Director for Environment and Place / Communities of the Council is empowered to modify or suspend this Order or any provision of it pursuant to and in accordance with Section 10(2) of the Act.
- 7. This Order shall continue in force for a period of 18 months from the date on which it comes into force.

### SCHEDULE

#### **Prohibition of Vehicles**

Article 46 is temporarily deleted and replaced as follows:

#### "St. Michaels Street

- 46. (1) Subject to article 46A, no person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Item 1 of Part T of Schedule 6.
  - (2) Nothing in part (1) of this Article shall apply to any:
    - (a) pedal cycle or scooter not being ridden/driven,
    - (b) to any Exempt Vehicle as defined in article 2 (a), (e), (f) & (g)."
- 46A. (1) No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Item 2 of Part T of Schedule 6.
  - (2) Nothing in part (1) of this Article shall apply:
    - (a) to any taxi;
    - (b) to any licensed private hire vehicle whilst:-
      - (i) carrying a passenger;
      - (ii) travelling to answer a call for hire;
    - (c) to any Exempt Vehicle;
    - (d) to any disabled persons' vehicle which is proceeding to or leaving any disabled persons' parking place in the length of road specified in Item 2 of Part T of Schedule 6;
    - (e) to any motor vehicle, the length of which does not exceed 5 metres which requires access for loading and unloading goods at premises in the length of road specified in Item 2 of Part T of Schedule 6;
    - (f) to any motor vehicle proceeding in the length of road specified in Item 2 of Part T of Schedule 6 to gain access to any private parking area in the said length of road provided that the driver of that vehicle is authorised by the owner or occupier of the private parking area to park there."

2.)

Part T of Schedule 6 is temporarily deleted and replace as follows:

#### "PART T (Article 46 of the Order)

- 1. St. Michaels Street, west of a point 12 metres west of from its junction with Cornmarket Street westwards for approximately 50 metres.
- 2. St. Michaels Street, west of a point approximately 50 metres west of its junction with Cornmarket Street."
