# (VARIATION No.21) ORDER 2023

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers contained in Sections 1(1), 2(2), 32, 35 and 45 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places - Oxford) (Variation No.21) Order 2023 and shall come into force on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of January 2023.
- 2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment
  - (2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa
  - (3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
