

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS – CHERWELL DISTRICT) (MAP BASED) (PROHIBITION AND
RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PERMITTED PARKING)
(VARIATION No.8) ORDER 2023**

The Oxfordshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 37, 45, 46, 49(4) and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the RTRA 1984") and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the RTRA 1984, and The Traffic Management Act 2004, Part 6 (as amended) make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads - Cherwell District) (Map Based) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Permitted Parking) (Variation No.8) Order 2023 and shall come into force on the 23rd day of October 2023.
2. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads - Cherwell District) (Map Based) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Permitted Parking) Order 2021, as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads – Cherwell) (Map Based) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Permitted Parking) (Variation No.1) Order 2021, the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads – Cherwell) (Map Based) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Permitted Parking) (Variation No.2) Order 2021, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads – Cherwell) (Map Based) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Permitted Parking) (Variation No.3) Order 2022, The Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads – Cherwell) (Map Based) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Permitted Parking) (Variation No.4) Order 2022, The Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford – Modification of Controlled Parking Zone Orders to Enable online Applications for Virtual Parking Permits) Order 2022, The Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads – Cherwell) (Map Based) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Permitted Parking) (Variation No.6) Order 2023, and The Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads – Cherwell) (Map Based) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Permitted Parking) (Variation No.7) Order 2023 ("the 2021 Order") is amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this order.
